

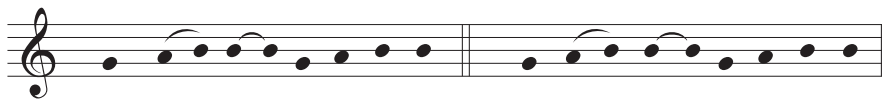
PENITENTIAL ACT

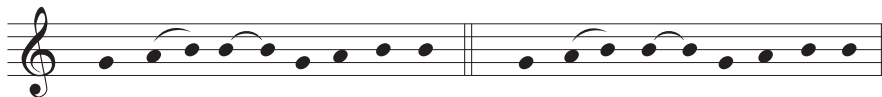




