Carrying her into her own apartment and placing her into her own bed, the old woman became the first of many thousands who would find a home of love, care and respect.

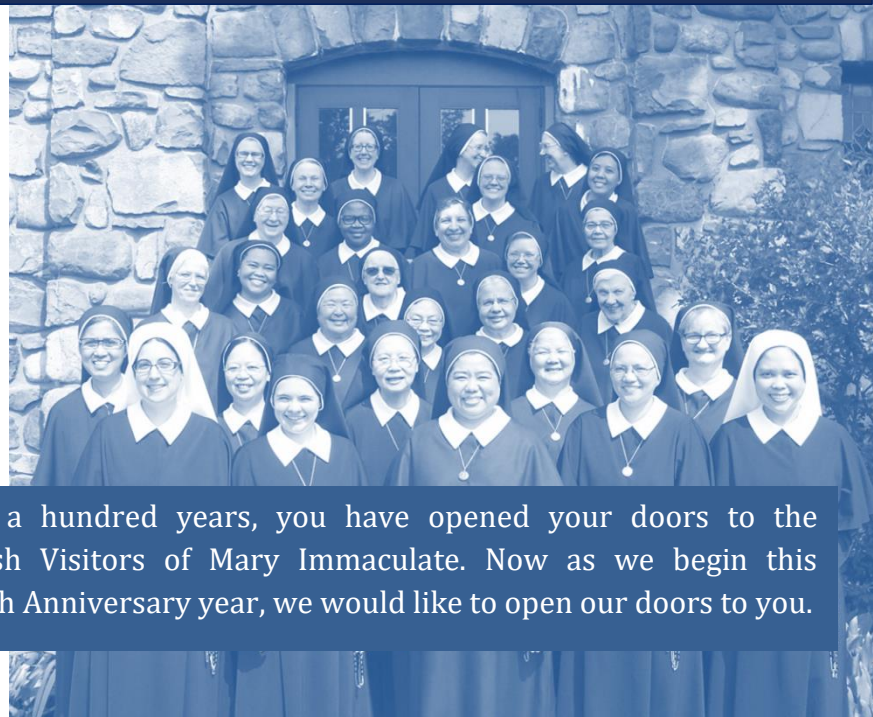
