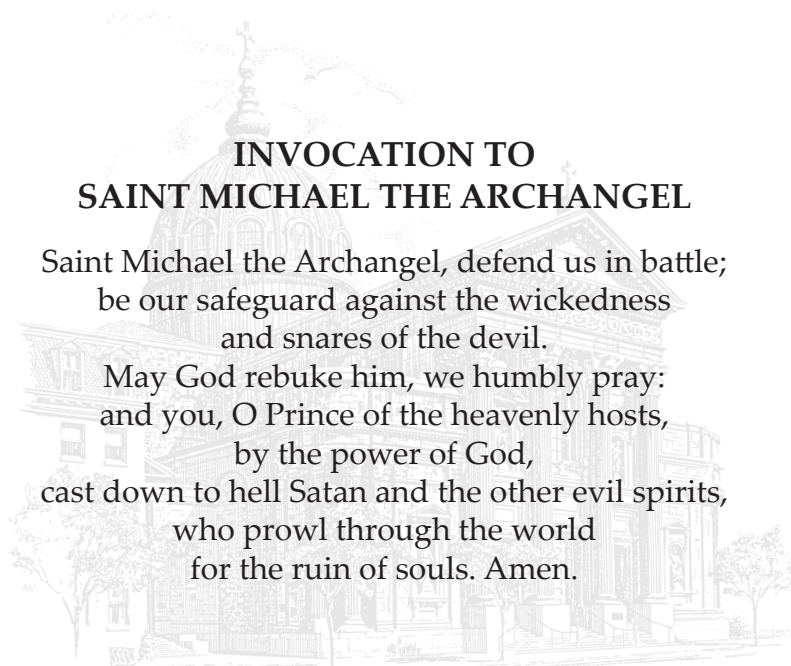
PENITENTIAL ACT
