Dear Parishioners,

This is the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Gospel for this Sunday provides an ever-timely exhortation from the Lord. "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid (Matthew 14: 27)." Jesus is addressing the disciples who are fearful because of the stormy weather tossing about their boat. The boat of our lives—which includes so many aspects and dimensions—can be tossed about by so many storms that pass our way. These "storms" often bring about much fear for many of us. This fear leads to all kinds of upset, confusion and disorientation. We need to allow our fear, all our fears, to be steadied by the confident embrace of the Lord for each of us. We belong to him and he belongs to us. He never abandons us. Let us take courage constantly in the Lord who makes our fear occasions of deeper faith.

This Saturday August 15, 2026, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. However, this is one of the three Holy Days that when it falls on a Monday or Saturday, the obligation is suspended since it falls back-to-back with Sunday. An effort should be made to assist at Holy Mass even though the obligation is suspended. This summer Holy Day fills us with the hope that what is Mary's eternal glory may one day come to each of us in the death and resurrection of her Divine Son. As we look forward to celebrating this great Solemnity, we turn to Mary, our Mother assumed into Heaven, and bring to her the many prayers that we have for so many intentions. The Mass and Confession schedule for the Solemnity can be found elsewhere in the bulletin.

Next Sunday Father Charles Kennedy will preach at all the Masses, including the Anticipated Mass, on behalf of the missions. Please see additional information on this summer's missions appeal elsewhere in the bulletin. Father Kennedy was stationed at one time at the Cathedral Parish and so we also welcome him back among us.

Summer is passing quickly and soon the children in our parish will be back in school. Parents, as you make preparations for the new school year, please do not forget the obligation to provide for the religious education of your children. For parents of children in a public or charter school, if your children are seven years of age, it is time to prepare them for First Penance and First Holy Communion. If your children are in the later years of elementary school, it is time to prepare them for the Sacrament of Confirmation. If it is time to prepare your children for the Sacraments, please contact our Director of Religious Education, Gina Ingiosi at gingiosi@archphila.org, as soon as possible.

Invite a family member, a neighbor and/or a friend to join you for Holy Mass next Sunday at the Cathedral Basilica.

Please keep the intention for peace in our City and an end to gun violence in our neighborhoods in your prayers. Our Lady, Queen of Peace, pray for us!

REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Hoy celebramos el décimo noveno domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. El evangelio de este domingo nos ofrece una exhortación del Señor que siempre es oportuna: “Tranquilícense y no teman Soy yo” (Mateo 14, 27). Jesús se dirige a los discípulos, quienes sienten temor debido a la tormenta que sacude su barca. La barca de nuestras vidas —que abarca tantos aspectos y dimensiones— puede verse sacudida por las numerosas tormentas que se cruzan en nuestro camino. A menudo, estas “tormentas” nos provocan gran temor, llevándonos a todo tipo de inquietud, confusión y desorientación. Debemos permitir que el abrazo lleno de confianza del Señor hacia cada uno de nosotros calme nuestros temores. Le pertenecemos a Él y Él nos pertenece a nosotros; nunca nos abandona. Cobremos ánimo constantemente en el Señor, quien transforma nuestros temores en ocasiones para una fe más profunda.

Este sábado 15 de agosto del 2026 celebramos la Solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María, día de precepto. Sin embargo, esta es una de las tres festividades en las que, si caen en lunes o sábado, se suspende la obligación de asistir a Misa por coincidir con el domingo. Aun así, debemos esforzarnos por asistir a la Santa Misa. Esta festividad veraniega nos llena de esperanza al pensar que la gloria eterna de María llegará algún día a cada uno de nosotros mediante la muerte y resurrección de su Divino Hijo. Mientras nos preparamos para celebrar esta gran solemnidad, acudimos a María, nuestra Madre asunta al Cielo, y le presentamos nuestras oraciones por tantas intenciones. En otra parte del boletín encontrarán el horario de Misas y confesiones para esta solemnidad.

El próximo domingo, el padre Charles Kennedy predicará en todas las Misas —incluida la Misa Anticipada— en nombre de las misiones. Por favor, consulten la información adicional sobre la campaña misionera de este verano en otra sección del boletín. El padre Kennedy sirvió anteriormente en la parroquia de la Catedral, por lo que le damos la bienvenida de nuevo entre nosotros.

Si cursan los últimos años de la escuela primaria, es hora de prepararlos para el sacramento de la Confirmación. Si ha llegado el momento de preparar a sus hijos para recibir los sacramentos, por favor comuníquense lo antes posible con nuestra directora de educación religiosa, Gina Ingiosi, a la dirección gingiosi@archphila.org.

Inviten a un familiar, a un vecino o a un amigo a acompañarlos a la Santa Misa el próximo domingo en la Catedral Basílica.

Por favor, incluyan en sus oraciones la intención de pedir por la paz en nuestra ciudad y el fin de la violencia armada en nuestros vecindarios. ¡Nuestra Señora, Reina de la Paz, ruega por nosotros!

Chuck Pfeffer's Challenge, an initiative celebrating the memory and ministry of Father Charles Pfeffer, a deceased beloved priest of our Archdiocese.

Over the last eighteen years, donors to Fr. Chuck's Challenge have provided more than 1,700 homes for desperately poor displaced families, previously living nearly homeless, in plastic and plank shelters, in an area frequently ravaged by tropical storms – in the Northern Highlands of Nicaragua and in hurricane ravaged Haiti. Current efforts have housed homeless in Honduras where the work continues.

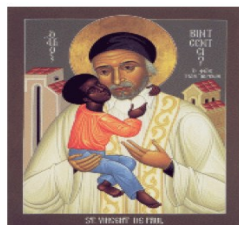
