


- 1. How lovely is your dwelling place, LORD God of hosts.

Exodus 3:1 - 8a, 13 - 15 5:15 PM Exodus 17: 3 - 7




- Bless the Lord O my soul: and forget not all his benefits. 2. He pardons all your iniquities; He heals all your ills.
