



I rejoiced when they said to me: "Let us go up to the Lord's house." And now our feet are standing within your gates O Jerusalem. (Antiphon)


Pray for the peace of Jerusalem! "May they prosper who love you! Peace be within your walls, and security within your towers!" (Antiphon)


By the streams of Babylon, we sat and wept remembering Zion. On the aspens of that land we hung our harps.
