WORDS FROM POPE FRANCIS.....

Reflecting on the words of any Pope helps us to grow in our faith—after all, he is our shepherd, the one who calls us on as one body in Christ. We will offer short excerpts taken from Pope Francis’ addresses and homilies since his election which will reflect the themes that we can expect to hear again and again during his pontificate.....

Dwelling in His Loving Wounds

Dear brothers and sisters, let us be enveloped by the mercy of God; let us trust in His patience, which always gives us more time. Let us find the courage to return to His house, to dwell in His loving wounds, allowing ourselves to be loved by Him and to encounter His mercy in the sacraments. We will feel His wonderful tenderness, we will feel His embrace, and we, too, will become more capable of mercy, patience, forgiveness and love.

The Lord’s Most Powerful Message

Jesus has this message for us: mercy. I think—and I say it with humility—that this is the Lord’s most powerful message: mercy.... But if we are like the Pharisee before the altar who said, “I thank you, Lord, that I am not like other men, and especially not like the one at the door, like that publican” (cf. Luke 18:11-12), then we do not know the Lord’s heart, and we will never have the joy of experiencing this mercy!

The Lord Is There First!

We say we must seek God, go to Him and ask forgiveness, but when we go, He is waiting for us; He is there first! In Spanish we have a word that explains this well: *primerear*—the Lord always gets there before us, He gets there first, He is waiting for us! To find someone waiting for you is truly a great grace. You go to Him as a sinner, but He is waiting to forgive you. This is the experience that the prophets of Israel describe, comparing the Lord to the almond blossom, the first flower of spring (cf. Jeremiah 1:11-12). Before any other flowers appear, He is there, waiting. The Lord is waiting for us.
