


Dox. Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, As it was in the beginning, is now, And will be forever. Amen.



CATHEDRAL BASILICA of SAINTS PETER AND PAUL SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME January 20, 2013







Cantor: Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.

Cantor: Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father.






