



Repeat after the Cantor and following each verse



- 1. O shepherd of Israel, here us, you who lead Joseph like a flock: enthroned on the cherubim shine forth.
- 2. O God, bring us back; Let your face shine upon us and we shall be saved. How long, O Lord, God of hosts, will you be angry at the prayer of your people.
- 3. You brought back a vine our of Egypt; you drove out the nations and planted it. Before it you cleared the ground; it took root and filled the land.
- 4. The mountains are covered with its shadow, the cedars of God with its boughs. It stretched out branches to the sea; to the river it stretched out its shoots.
- 5. Then why have they broken down its walls? It is plucked by all who pass by the way. It is ravaged by the boar of the forest, devoured by the beasts of the field.


