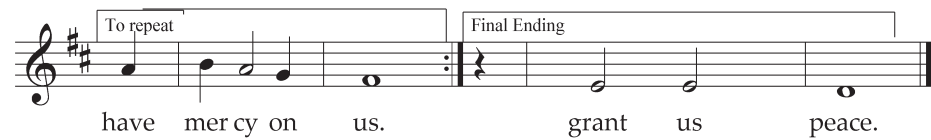

Not one of his bones shall be broken.

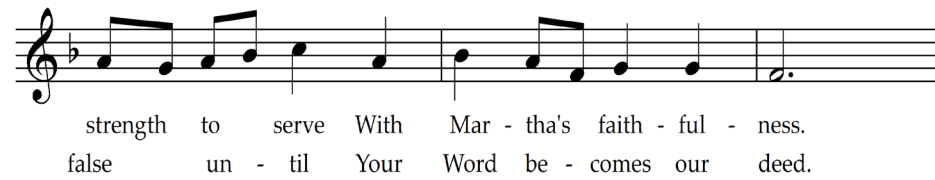
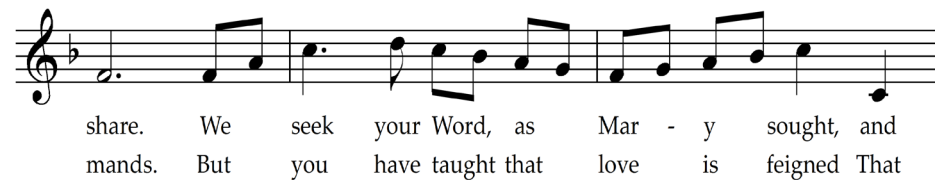
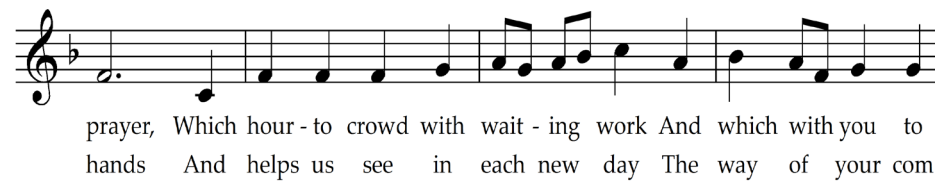
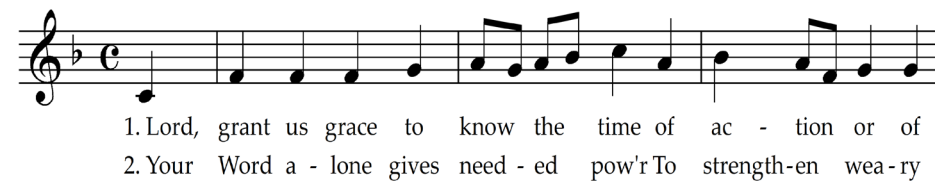
