when you would turn to the right or to the left.

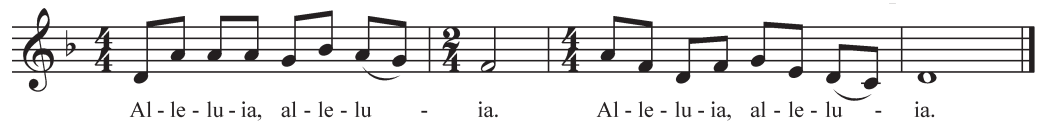
He will give rain for the seed

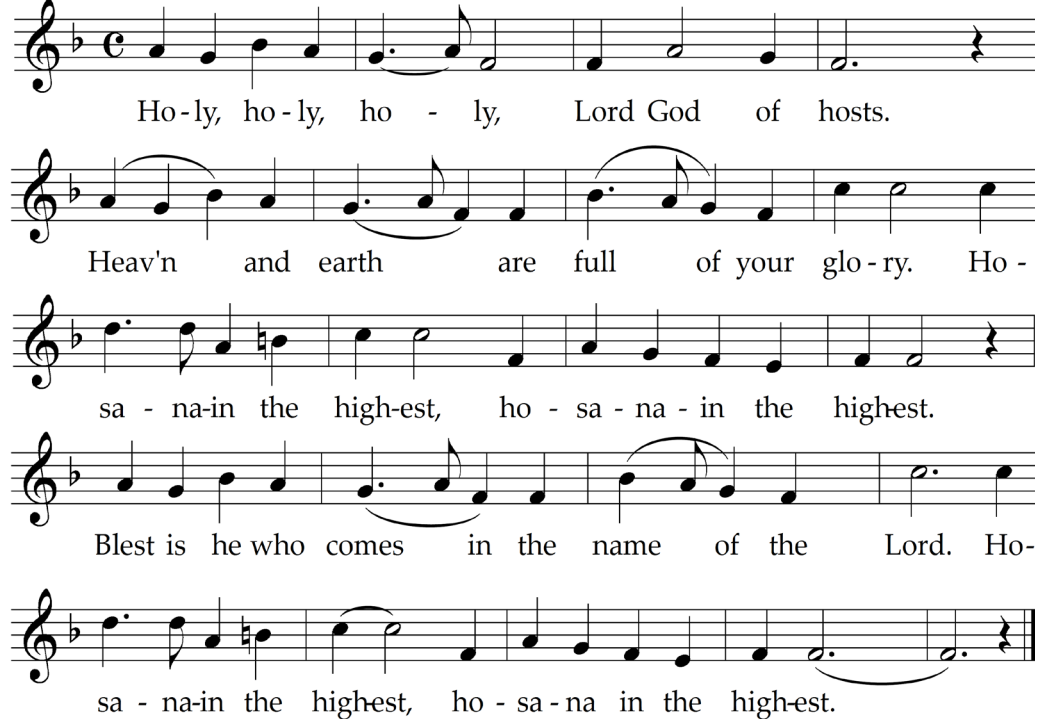

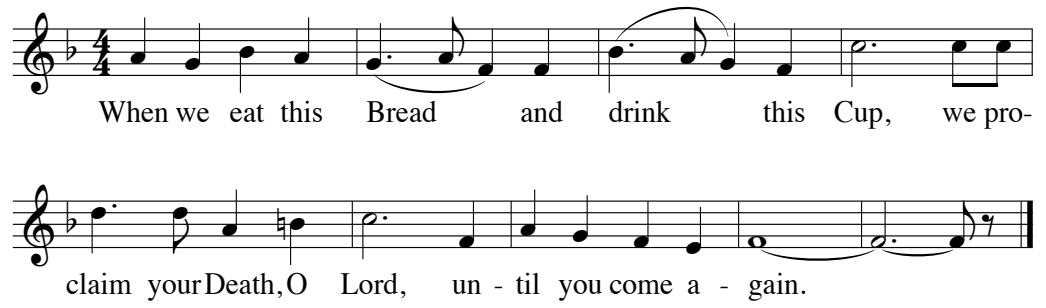
