heaven sings alleluia; alleluia the earth replies.

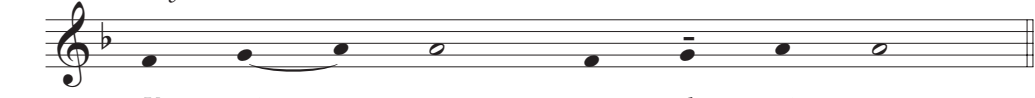

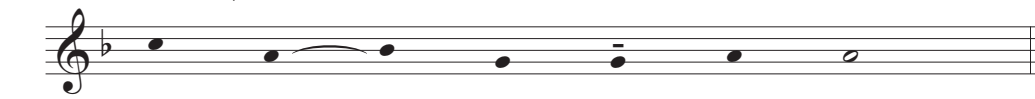

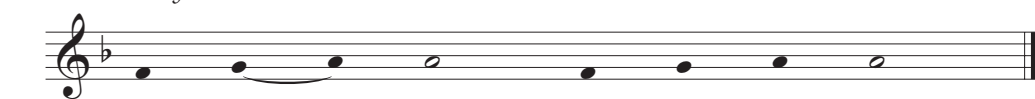
