THE CATHEDRAL PARISH WELCOMES THE HOLY FATHER. This is the script on the banner that will hang, beginning this Wednesday, above the front doors of the Basilica. The Cathedral Basilica is a focal point for the visit of our Holy Father to Philadelphia for the conclusion of the World Meeting of Families this September. In fact, as you may already know, the Holy Father will celebrate two Masses during his two day visit to our City. On Saturday, September 26, 2015, the Holy Father will offer Mass in the Basilica for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The congregation for this Mass will be representatives of the Clergy, those in the Consecrated Life and members of the lav faithful from throughout the Archdiocese. Tickets will be issued by the World Meeting of Families for participation in this Mass. On Sunday, September 27, 2015, the Holy Father will offer Mass on the Benjamin Franklin Parkway in the late afternoon. This Mass is open to everyone. As we get closer to the September dates, I will provide you with more information on Cathedral Parish events and the Papal events.

One of the principal projects of our Parish Committee to prepare for the World Meeting of Families is the opening of our *Cathedral Shop*. The *Cathedral Shop* will be located temporarily off the Race Street entrance to the Basilica. Many people have worked very hard for the *Cathedral Shop* to open this summer and hopefully we can announce opening day very soon. This shop will provide a much needed service to our parishioners and many visitors who often are looking for a religious article or a commemorative of the Cathedral Basilica. I also hope the shop will be a help to spread our Catholic Faith and loving hospitality to all who come to the Basilica. We are counting on your support of our new *Cathedral Shop*. The plan is to have a more permanent *Cathedral Shop* after the World Meeting of Families in September.

Our landscaping committee has done a marvelous job this summer taking on the refurbishing of our grounds for the upcoming World Meeting of Families and for the future. This committee is in need of more volunteers for the routine care and maintenance of the grounds. Living Stewardship Now BREAD OF HEAVEN

When the land is stricken with famine, Elisha the prophet believes God will provide, and he is given twenty barley loaves and some grain. A small crowd eats it, and some is left over. Jesus feeds thousands with five loaves and two fish. Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, blesses the bread, and distributes it. The crowd eat their fill, and the leftovers fill twelve baskets. These are the actions of the priest today as we are fed the bread of life. Elisha trusted that God would provide, and God did. God indeed provides overflowing abundance. Christ gives us himself as food, totally and completely. We in turn must feed other people. Feeding people in our parish creates a welcoming atmosphere. Feeding poor people helps them stop worrying about their next meal. Feeding those in a crisis or natural disaster keeps them alive. Feeding people is God's work, and our work, too.
