

Dicit Dominus: Implete hydrias aqua et ferte architriclino. Cum gustasset architriclinus aquam vinum factam, dicit sponso: Servasti vinum bonum usque adhuc. Hoc signum fecit Iesus primum coram discipulis suis.

The Lord said: Fill the jars with water and bring some to the master of the feast. When the master of the feast tasted the water, which had now become wine, He declared to the bridegroom: You have saved the best wine until now. This was the first sign which Jesus accomplished before his disciples.

The bridegroom rejoices in his bride.




Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all you lands. Sing to the Lord; bless his name.


