


Sing, my soul, His wondrous love, Who, from yon bright throne above,



Priest: Have mercy on us, O Lord.


People: For we have sinned against you.

I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord. Our feet shall stand within thy gates, O Jerusalem.
