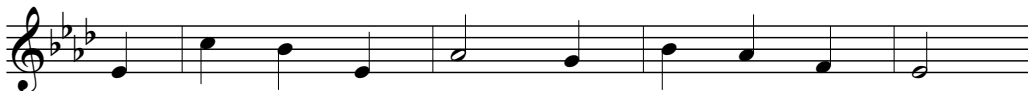

for according to his own words, God will take care of him.

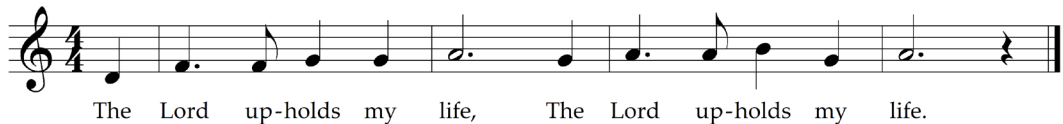


