Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Solemnity of Pentecost, the eighth Sunday of Easter Time! We have been celebrating the great Christian Mystery of the Resurrection of Jesus for fifty days. This week several of our Archdiocesan and Private Catholic High Schools will celebrate their Baccalaureate Masses at the Cathedral Basilica. These Masses are memorable occasions for the graduates and their families, fittingly thanking God for the blessings of a Catholic education. Let us keep in prayer all those graduating throughout the Archdiocese. May they continue to mature in their faith and know God's nearness to them as they look forward to the next steps in their lives.


