



Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, July 3, 2022, we celebrate our Patronal Feast of the Apostles, Saints Peter and Paul. The actual observance was Wednesday, June 29, 2022. The Church allows during Ordinary Time for a community to observe its feast in a more public manner on the nearest Sunday. And so, today we commemorate our heavenly patrons in a festive and public way at all the parish Masses. Saints Peter and Paul continue to lead us to Christ through his Church. Saint Peter recalls for us the foundation of the Church on the Apostles and the central role of the Vicar of Christ in passing on the one and same Faith in every generation. We ask Saint Peter to pray for our Holy Father and for all of us to be ever firm in the Faith of the Apostles and to make it known in every way possible. Saint Paul recalls for us the power and presence of the Divine Word in the Church and in the life of Christians. We ask Saint Paul to pray for all the members of the Church to receive the Word not as the word of men but as truly the living Word of God (see 1 Thessalonians 2: 13). Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us!

Tomorrow, Monday, July 4, 2022, Independence Day, Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 AM in the Cathedral Chapel. Following the 9:00 AM Mass on July Fourth, everyone is invited to join in praying the Holy Rosary for the intentions of our nation. The Basilica and the Parish Office will be closed on Independence Day.

Summer is a good time for some additional reading, especially some spiritual reading. I encourage you to read the life of a saint or a book on prayer. An author that I particularly enjoy and find helpful is Father Jacques Philippe. He has many fine accessible works to help the busy Christian to deepen our life in Christ. The US Catholic Bishops recently published a fine short piece, The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church (available in our Cathedral Shop). This booklet is a great refresher on the great gift to the Church of the Holy Eucharist.

Our Christian Initiation Ministry for adults is a robust work here at the Cathedral Parish. This past Easter Time, more than twenty adults received the Easter Sacraments. Parish sponsors are a critical aspect of this ministry. These are committed Catholic adults that are willing to accompany and mentor those seeking the Sacraments in the ways of the Faith. As our number increases of interested adults in the Sacraments, so our need for additional sponsors increases. Please consider this ministry of parish sponsor and let me know if you are able to serve the parish in this way. Thank you!

Please see elsewhere in this edition of the Parish Bulletin information on the preparation for the Sacraments - Confirmation, Penance and Reconciliation, and First Holy Communion - for school-age children. Please do not delay in making contact with the Parish Office for enrollment in this preparation program.

The second collection at Mass next Sunday will be directed to the poor and needy in the neighborhood of the Cathedral Parish. 

Estimados feligreses,

Este domingo 3 de julio del 2022 celebramos nuestra Fiesta Patronal de los Apóstoles, San Pedro y San Pablo. La celebración real fue el miércoles 29 de junio del 2022. La Iglesia permite durante el Tiempo Ordinario que una comunidad observe su fiesta de una manera más pública el domingo más cercano. Y así, hoy conmemoramos a nuestros celestiales patrones de manera festiva y pública en todas las Misas parroquiales. San Pedro y San Pablo continúan llevándonos a Cristo a través de su Iglesia. San Pedro nos recuerda el fundamento de la Iglesia sobre los apóstoles y el papel central del Vicario de Cristo en la transmisión de la única y misma Fe en cada generación. 
Listening to God More Closely: **Spiritual Direction**

Cathedral Sacramental Preparation 2022-2023

The Cathedral Parish will offer classes again this coming year for children who need to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. This is NOT a full religious education program.

Your child may attend these classes whether he or she is attending a Catholic school in the Archdiocese, is in a religious education program at another parish, is **NOT** in religious education, or is in a home-based program.

There will be a section of each class for primarily English-speaking children/families, and another for primarily Spanish-speaking children/families.

The schedule for 2022-2023 will be out very soon! Classes for the English-speaking section will start on October. Children coming for First Holy Communion preparation will be prepared for the Sacrament of Penance during the fall; after New Year classes will focus on the Holy Eucharist and specific preparation for First Holy Communion. Confirmation preparation will follow the same schedule.

More information will be on this website very soon, along with registration forms! Please stay tuned!

The Sacrament of Confirmation for school age children will be on Sunday, April 16, 2023 at the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass.

Bishop Joseph Coffey will administer the Sacrament.

First Holy Communion will be on Sunday, May 7, 2023 At the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass.


