Dear Parishioners,

Our celebration of Christmas continues with this Sunday's observance of the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. The traditional date for the Solemnity of the Epiphany is January 6. However, in those countries where the Epiphany is not observed as a Holy Day of Obligation, like in the United States, the celebration is moved to the nearest Sunday. So today, on this day - which is sometimes referred to as "Little Christmas" - we praise our Almighty Father for the manifestation of the Birth of his Divine Son to all the world. The Kings, the Magi, come with their gifts to honor the Infant Savior but receive from him the gift that is also for us. Jesus is revealed to all the nations, all people in every place and for every time, as the promised Redeemer and Savior. As we too adore Jesus, let us pray for the grace - an openness to the gift of our Redeemer and Savior - to hear more fully his Word and to live more completely his Way of life.

Christmas Time comes to its liturgical conclusion with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord which this year is celebrated tomorrow, Monday, January 9, 2023. If possible, come to the 7:15 AM or 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Chapel as we bring this holy and festive time to a fitting conclusion.

I apologize to you once again for the delay with the Christmas mailing. The envelope company - a different one than employed previously--gave me a variety of reasons for the delay which I know was an inconvenience for many. The mailing finally arrived to most of you a few days after Christmas Day. Thank you to all of you who made use of the Christmas Gift envelope on Sunday, January 1, 2023. With the delay with the Christmas mailing, there were very few contributions for Christmas flowers and so we will not be publishing a list of donors this year. The Masses were offered the three days following Christmas for those who had any special Christmas remembrances. I am looking into other possibilities for the Easter mailing to avoid another mishap. Thank you for your understanding.

On Monday, February 6, 2023, the 2024 Mass Book opens for the scheduling of announced Masses for that year. Additionally, beginning on this same day, Weddings can be scheduled for 2024. I encourage you to arrange for the offering of Holy Mass for your loved ones, living and deceased, for all the spiritual benefits that come from the Sacrifice of Christ on the Cross in the Eucharist. This is especially important for those who have recently died that they be united to the saving death of the Lord for his promise of Eternal Life.

The location of our Cathedral Basilica and Chapel in the heart of Center City allows it to be a place of refuge for the homeless all throughout the day. We have a Christian duty to see the homeless men and women who spend time during the day in the Basilica and Chapel as our brothers and sisters in the Lord. At the same time, issues of safety and respect are also of equal concern. If you see any behavior that is not acceptable, please notify one of the priests or sacristans immediately. Panhandling in the church is forbidden and I ask you not to participate in this. **Also, please be mindful not to leave your personal belongings behind in the pew at any time.**

Thank you to all our parishioners and visitors for your goodness and generosity to the Cathedral Parish. The second collection next Sunday will be directed to the religious education programs in the Cathedral Parish. 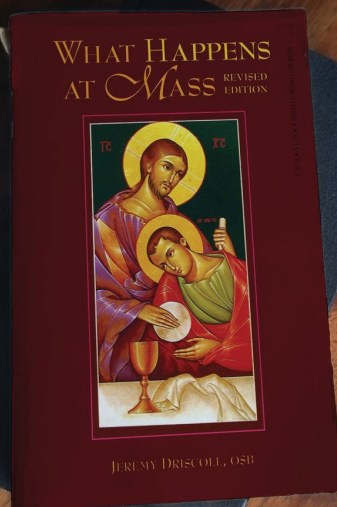
