

Dear Parishioners,

This is the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Holy Gospel for this Sunday provides a wonderful preparation for Lent. The Lord gives a fuller explanation to observing the commandments along with some excellent examples. It is insufficient only to know the commandments as a follower of the Lord or even to observe them only in an overarching way. Rather, as the Lord instructs, we are to obey them completely and teach others to do the same. In the days ahead as we anticipate Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent, let us spend some time, with the Ten Commandments in mind, looking for the ways we need to address our failure or omission to be true to the ways of the Lord. Let us commit with the nearness of Lent to seek more sincerely to turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel.

Today, the second Sunday of February is World Marriage Day. Our American Bishops encourage us to observe this day with prayer for the dignity and protection of Marriage, especially Christian Marriage. Of all the Christian vocations, Marriage suffers the most from a near collapse in our time. The incredible disregard among Christians of the Gospel and Church teaching against cohabitation before Marriage, openness to and respect for natural conception, and, more recently, an unambiguous understanding of Marriage as the faithful and permanent union between a man and a woman, definitely compels us to pray for Marriage. Our prayer needs to be united to a reception in our hearts and minds of the Gospel and Church teaching on the institution and Sacrament of Marriage. Today, World Marriage Day, invites all of us to do our part, especially with engaged couples to support them in their fidelity to the Lord's plan for Marriage. Let us remember today in our prayers all married couples. May the Lord keep them safe in their married lives and may they be a reminder to all of us of the love Christ has for his holy Church.

Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023, is just ten days away. Baskets will again be the entrances to the Basilica next Sunday for your old blessed palm. This palm from last year's Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord will be burned for this year's ashes for Ash Wednesday. If you do not bring your palm to church, please dispose of it carefully by burning it or burying it. Please take note of the insert in today's Parish Bulletin which lists the many ways to observe Lent 2023 here at the Cathedral Parish.

The 2009 Archdiocesan Heritage of Faith Campaign case statement, that projected for much needed financial resources for the Cathedral Basilica, did not include the renovation of lightning. I draw your attention to the fact that we are petitioning for the inclusion of this project so that the Cathedral Basilica can benefit from the remaining funds of this campaign.

Please keep the intention for peace in our City and an end to gun violence in our neighborhoods in your prayers. Our Lady, Queen of Peace, pray for us!





# THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism is the doorway to the Christian life and to all the other Sacraments. As such, preparation of the parents and for the Baptism itself deserve very special attention. The celebration of Baptism at the Cathedral Parish takes place on the <u>FIRST Sunday</u> of each month at 12:30 PM after the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass. Everyone is welcome. The celebration will be carried out with liturgical music and with a great sense of hospitality.

Upcoming Baptisms: March 5; April 9; May 7, 2023

Most of the *Baptism Preparation Sessions* take place on the **THIRD Sunday** of each month at 12:30 PM in anticipation of the celebration of the Sacrament. Parents in the Cathedral Parish are obligated to participate. The session is open to all of our neighbor parishes and to godparents as well. Parents are encouraged to participate during pregnancy, if at all possible.
