

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Seventh Sunday of Easter! In the Gospel today, we hear an editorial comment inserted into the words of Jesus. "Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ (John 17:3)." The Church is in the midst of the Pentecost Novena, praying intensely for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon all her members with the celebration of Pentecost next Sunday. It is one thing to pray for the increased manifestation and presence of the Holy Spirit in our time and in our lives. It is all together another thing to pray with the help of the Holy Spirit to know the Lord. I suggest that this comment by the evangelist in today's Gospel is something we all need to ask of God, the Holy Spirit - to know truly Jesus Christ. As we pray for the renewed coming of the Holy Spirit, let us also pray this same Spirit will aid all of us in growing in our knowledge and love of God a personal and intimate knowledge and love. This will lead to a greater commitment to the Christian life and the service of others. Come, Holy Spirit, Come!

This is the Collect for Mass for the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Please add it to your prayers today.

Graciously hear our supplications, O Lord, so that we, who believe that the Savior of the human race is with you in your glory, may experience, as he promised, until the end of the world, his abiding presence among us. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Next Sunday is the Eighth Sunday of Easter, Pentecost Sunday, May 28, 2023. Pentecost Sunday brings to a close the long Sunday of Easter Time, our fifty-day celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord.

The extended Vigil of Pentecost will take place at the Cathedral Basilica on May 27, 2023 at 5:15 PM. This is an opportunity to pray in an intense way for the coming of the Holy Spirit to the Church in our time. Also, Archbishop Nelson Perez will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for Catholic Adults from all over the Archdiocese at the 11:00 AM Sunday Mass on Pentecost.




