

Dear Parishioners,

Come, Holy Spirit, Come! Fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Come, Holy Spirit, Come!

Today is the Solemnity of Pentecost and with it, our fifty-day celebration of Easter comes to a close. The Paschal Candle will make its return to the baptistery at the end of this day. Tomorrow, the liturgical time during the year, Ordinary Time, resumes. Although our liturgical transition from the privileged time of Easter to Ordinary Time happens within a day. we need to keep up, in a sense with the Pentecost outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is traditionally referred to as the Birthday of the Church. We have been asking the Holy Spirit, especially with the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy since the holy day of the Ascension, to come upon the whole Church and each of us in a new way, with new gifts and new graces. Today, the Holy Spirit does just this in a way that may be imperceptible at first but profoundly powerful. It is for us -as we pray over the next few days, perhaps come to daily Mass and read the Word of God in our homes - to see how the fire of the love of the Holy Spirit ignites our hearts for greater love of God, faithfulness to his ways and service to one another. In this way, the Church is renewed with us and among us. Come, Holy Spirit, Come!

This is the Collect for Mass for the Solemnity of Pentecost. Please add it to your prayers today.

O God, who by the mystery of today's great feast sanctify your whole Church in every people and nation, pour out, we pray, the gifts of the Holy Spirit across the face of the earth and, with the divine grace that was at work when the Gospel was first proclaimed, fill now once more the hearts of believers. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Saint John's continues to provide crucial, life-sustaining services with dignity, respect and compassion to homeless men in Philadelphia.
