When we receive Holy Communion, we eat and drink the very death and resurrection of Christ we are celebrating. Please take some time today to reflect on the great gift of Jesus to his Church, to each of us, in the Holy Eucharist. Let us pray that our faith in this wonderful Mystery will increase and our Christian lives will be more deeply rooted in this same Mystery.

The Collect for the Mass of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ gives us a splendid summary of the Church's faith and understanding of the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Consider making it a part of your prayers today and over the next few days.

O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption. Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

This Friday, June 16, 2023, is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In fact, June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion recalls for us the immediate and constant love of Jesus for each of us. If possible, plan to come to Mass on Friday at 7:15 AM or 12:05 PM in the Cathedral Chapel.
