I also welcome Father Philip Bochanski. Father Bochanski is the new Moderator of the Curia and a Vicar General for the Archdiocese. He will reside in our Cathedral Rectory and assist us in the parish when possible. Please keep all our parish priests in your prayers, especially at this time of transition.

Our Keys and Sword Event this past Friday, June 23, 2023, was another success beyond our expectations. I am so very grateful to all of you who supported the event in any way. The Keys and Sword Event goes a long way to promote a wider culture of financial support for our Cathedral Basilica.

This Thursday, June 29, 2023, is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles, the patrons of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and of our Cathedral Basilica. We will celebrate our feast day twice. On Thursday, the actual day, we will commemorate these Holy Apostles at the 7:15 AM Mass in the Chapel and at the 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Basilica. Next Sunday, we will observe the Solemnity at all the Sunday Masses, including the Anticipated Mass. We turn to our heavenly patrons to pray for us, especially in these days, that we may be faithful to Jesus in every way.

The celebration of the anniversary of the Dedication of the Cathedral Basilica is on Friday, June 30, 2023, and will be observed at the 7:15 AM Mass in the Chapel and at the 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Basilica.

Please continue to pray for the intention of Religious Freedom in our country. This Sunday evening at 5:30 PM, there will be a Holy Hour in the Cathedral Basilica to pray especially for this intention. This is a pressing intention with each passing day as our freedom to conduct our Christian lives according to our Christian values is successfully impeded. All are welcome to the Holy Hour.

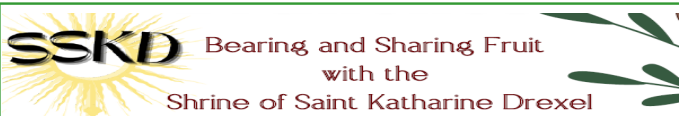

SUMMER BOOK CLUB FOR RACIAL HEALING

This Summer, we'll read and pray our way through a book by Maureen H. O'Connell, *Undoing the Knots: Five Generations of American Catholic Anti-Blackness*. Maureen is a parishioner in Philadelphia and a professor at La Salle University, and her book explores the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's history through the lens of her Irish Catholic ancestors.

We will have peer-guided gatherings to reflect on how the sin of racism has affected not only our historical past, but also continues into our present. Understanding the historical legacy we've inherited is the first step towards learning how to begin to heal the effects that racism has on all of us.

The first two sessions will take place on Friday, July 7th and 21st at 7pm ET. The final meeting will take place on Thursday, August 17th at 7pm ET. All sessions will take place in the Neumann Room. For the final meeting, the author, Maureen O'Connell, will join us to speak about her journey in writing the book, as well as to answer our questions.

The meetings will be co-facilitated by Marcelle McGuirk, and will be in collaboration with New Encounters: Catholics Confronting Racism.

Cathedral Ambassadors

The Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul conducts an evangelization ministry with the *Cathedral Ambassadors*. This enthusiastic group of trained Ambassadors staffs the Basilica throughout the week and is comprised of volunteers from all over the Archdiocese. They answer questions and offer assistance to all who come to the Cathedral Basilica. *Cathedral Ambassadors* provide a personal presence in the Basilica and most importantly they put a face on the Church. *Cathedral Ambassadors* are assigned 4 hour shifts.
