

Priest: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.





Perverse and foolish, oft I stray'd But yet in love he sought me, And gently on his shoulder laid, And home, rejoicing, brought me.


