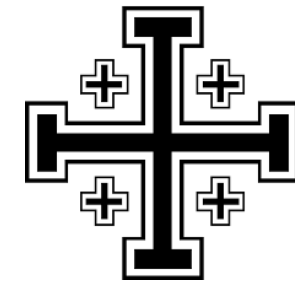

WISDOM 3:1-9

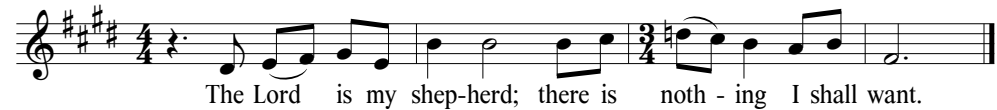
The souls of the just are in the hand of God,

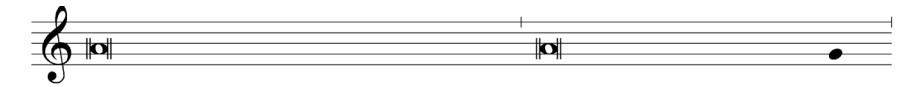

and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

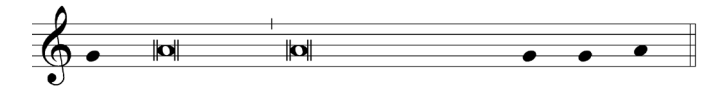

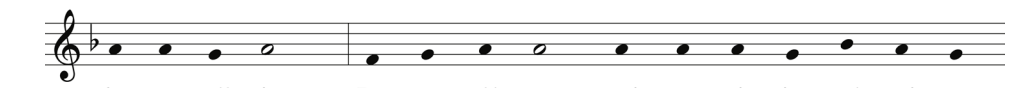
