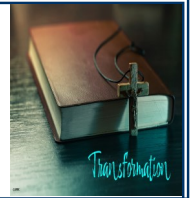

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Holy Gospel for this Sunday again presents Jesus at the beginning of his public ministry. Last Sunday, Saint Mark recalled the central message of the Lord for this ministry. "This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel (Mark 1:15)." Today, Saint Mark declares that Jesus teaches us as one with authority. His authority comes from his own divinity and the mission entrusted to him by the Father to be our Savior and Redeemer. Let us turn to Jesus, give ourselves over to his authority over our lives, and receive in faith all that he teaches us.

This Sunday begins Catholic Schools Week. Many of us know the great value of the Catholic School as part of our own educational experience. This week acknowledges the blessings of a Catholic School education. We honor the administrations, teachers, and staff of our Catholic Schools. We support the families that make the choice for Catholic Schools. The Cathedral Parish is especially grateful to Saint Francis Xavier Catholic School, our partner for the Catholic education of our parish school-age children.

The Blessing of Candles will take place on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, Friday, February 2, 2024, at the 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Chapel.

The Blessing of Throats will take place on the Memorial of Saint Blaise, Saturday, February 3, 2024, at 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Chapel. The Blessing of Throats will also take place at the Sunday Masses, including the Anticipated Mass, on February 4, 2024.

World Day for Consecrated Life takes place throughout the Church on Friday, February 2, 2024, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. In parishes in the United States, it is observed next Sunday, February 4, 2024. Please pray with gratitude for all those who have professed vows in the consecrated life. May they continue to be inspired by Jesus Christ and respond generously to the holy gift of their vocations. Archbishop Perez will celebrate the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass next Sunday, February 4, 2024, for the Consecrated Men and Women in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

Lent is around the corner! Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024. For the next two Sundays, February 4 and 11, 2024, there will be a basket near the entrance to the sacristy to collect old blessed palm. Please bring any old palm you may have at home to church on one of these Sundays. Old blessed palm is used for the ashes to be blessed and imposed on Ash Wednesday.

Please note that on Monday, February 5, 2024, the 2025 Mass Book opens for the scheduling of Weddings for 2025. The scheduling of announced Masses for 2025 will begin at a later date which will be announced in the parish bulletin and on the parish website.
