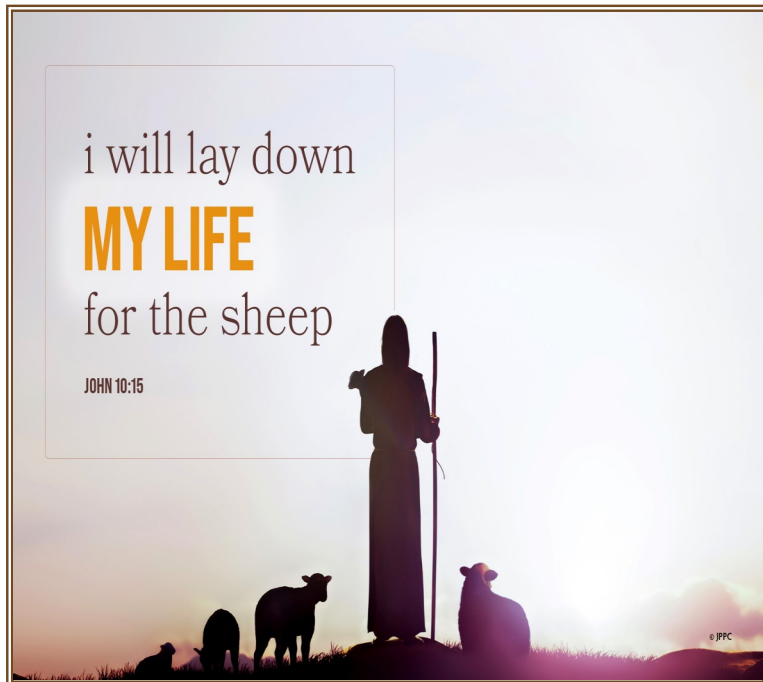

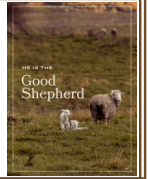

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter, Good Shepherd Sunday. In the Holy Gospel for this Sunday, the Good Shepherd, the Risen Lord, speaks a comforting word to us. "I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep (John 10: 14-15)." Our Shepherd Jesus expresses an intimate and grace-filled relationship with all of us who belong to him in his Resurrection. He knows us deeply and so calls us to follow him in a complete way. To hear the Good Shepherd and follow his way brings the promise of sharing in his Resurrection with eternal life. As we observe this Good Shepherd Sunday, let us turn to our Risen Savior with renewed conviction that he alone is the center of our lives and so directs all that we do. Let us live now with a singularity of focus as if we are already with him in glory. This is the Christian life lived in the grace of the Resurrection.

Good Shepherd Sunday is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations to the holy priesthood and the consecrated life. The Church is always in need of more numerous vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life to continue the work of the Good Shepherd - in so many ways - among us. Let us pray this Sunday, especially for more numerous vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life all throughout the Archdiocese. *Good Shepherd, hear our prayers!*

The Cathedral Basilica is at the same time the Mother Church of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and our parish church. Frequently, and especially during the spring of each year, there are many different groups that come to the Cathedral Basilica for special celebrations during the regularly scheduled Sunday Masses. These celebrations, especially when they draw a very large number of visitors, are never intended to displace our parishioners. As we graciously welcome these visitors to be among us, the pews on either side of the main aisle are always available for our parishioners for their participation in Holy Mass. Your understanding of any inconvenience when we have many visitors at the regularly scheduled Masses is most appreciated.
