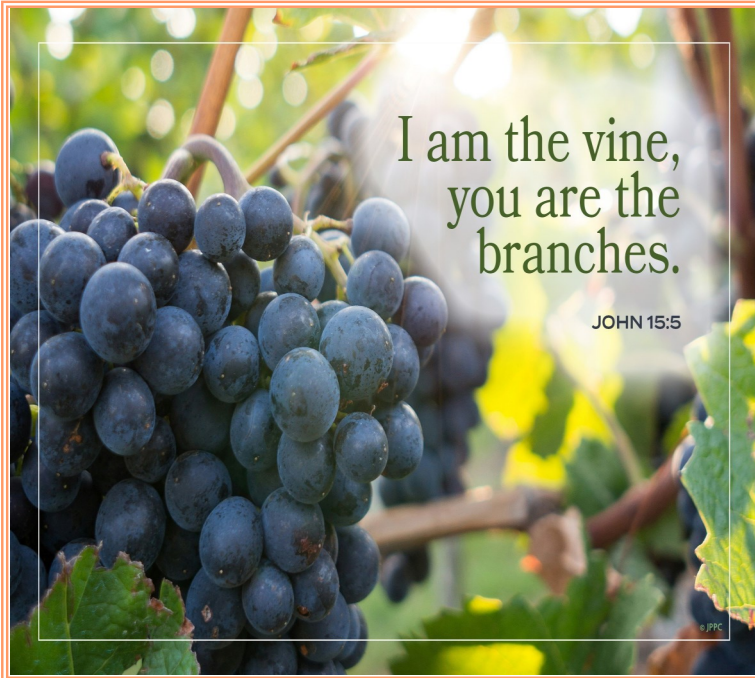

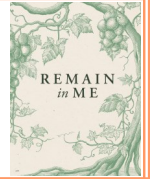

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Fifth Sunday of Easter! The Church this Sunday once again celebrates the wonderful saving news that Christ who died for us has been raised from the dead. Our faith in the Resurrection of the Lord cannot be taken for granted but rather this faith requires constant attention and deepening on our part. The eight Sunday celebrations of Easter each year are only one way to keep this faith in front of us and to allow us to reflect on its wonder and power. Additionally, our personal investment in our Easter faith provides us with the strength we need to live our Christian lives with clarity and peace. I encourage you as the weeks of Easter pass to read over again the biblical narratives of the Resurrection, to receive Holy Communion with the awareness that you receive the Risen Lord, and to be intentional in your witness to the Risen Lord in your daily life.

The month of May begins on Wednesday, May 1, 2024, and is traditionally a month to express special devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. I encourage you to take some time during the days of May to make our traditional Marian prayers a part of your daily prayers - the *Regina Coeli*, the *Angelus*, the *Memorare*, and most of all, the *Hail Mary*. Pray the Holy Rosary. Sometimes we can only manage a decade, and this is fine at times. I also encourage you to honor Mary in your home with a statue or picture of our Blessed Mother prominently displayed. With such a statue or picture in sight, we are more inclined to turn to Mary in prayer. Reading the biblical stories of our Blessed Mother awakens us to her role in her Son's life and our salvation. *We will have our parish May Crowning following the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass next Sunday, May 5, 2024. All are invited all during May to bring flowers to our Blessed Mother's altars in the Basilica and Chapel.*

You may have noticed in the parish bulletin over the past several weeks the announcement of a service that helps parishioners to write your will for free. This service reminds us to be prepared with a will at the time of our death. This service also allows for a gift to the Cathedral Basilica or another Catholic charity of your choice. Please see the notice in this Sunday's parish bulletin.

The next several weeks are very important for the success of our Parish Keys and Sword Event 2024. By now all our parishioners should have received their personal invitation in the mail. Please purchase a ticket and join us for this wonderful parish event. We all need to work together for the success of our Parish Keys and Sword Event 2024. I repeat my invitation to our parishioners to ask among business associates and other institutions, especially restaurants, to consider an ad in our Ad Book. We depend on the success of the Keys and Sword Event to supplement the many significant operational needs of the Cathedral Basilica. ¡Hoy es el quinto domingo de Pascua! Este domingo la Iglesia celebra una vez más la maravillosa noticia salvadora de que Cristo, que murió por nosotros, ha resucitado de entre los muertos. Nuestra fe en la Resurrección del Señor no puede darse por sentada, sino que esta fe requiere atención y profundización constante de nuestra parte. Las ocho celebraciones dominicales de Pascua de cada año son sólo una manera de mantener esta fe frente a nosotros y permitirnos reflexionar sobre su maravilla y poder. Además, nuestra inversión personal en nuestra fe pascual nos proporciona la fuerza que necesitamos para vivir nuestra vida cristiana con claridad y paz. Los animo a medida que pasan las semanas de Pascua a leer nuevamente los relatos bíblicos de la Resurrección, a recibir la Sagrada Comunión con la conciencia de que reciben al Señor Resucitado y a ser intencionales en su testimonio del Señor Resucitado en su vida diaria.
