Today is the Sixth Sunday of Easter! The Risen Lord invites us in the Gospel for this Sunday of Easter to remain in his love. To remain in the Lord's love reminds us that we have been chosen by the Lord for an intimate friendship with him, to keep his commandments, to have the Spirit's gift of joy and to manifest this love. Let us pray for one another and support one another to remain in the love of the Risen Lord!

This Thursday, May 9, 2024, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, is a Holy Day of Obligation. A Holy Day should be considered like a Sunday regarding our duty and obligation to participate in Mass. Maybe in the past, you have not been careful about your observance of Holy Days throughout the course of the year. Let this Holy Day change that pattern. We observe the Holy Days for very positive reasons. They celebrate aspects of God's saving plan for all of us. The Ascension of the Lord is part of the promise of the Resurrection. Because Jesus was raised from the dead, we too have the hope of being raised up with him. The Ascension completes the Resurrection of Jesus as he takes his place at the right hand of his Father. Likewise, we, who have the promise of the Resurrection, also have the promise in the Risen Lord to join him one day at the right hand of his Father. May is the month of Ordinations of new deacons and priests for the Archdiocese. Archbishop Pérez will ordain new transitional deacons on Saturday, May 11, 2024, and new priests on Saturday, May 18, 2024, both at 10:00 AM at the Cathedral Basilica. All parishioners are welcome to these Ordinations. Let us keep these men in our prayers as they prepare to receive this great gift of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Holy Orders.


