Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! How many times a day do we make the Sign of the Cross? This gesture which professes our faith in the Triune God can be a rather routine gesture in many cases. In fact, the mystery of the Holy Trinity - three equally divine persons in one God - can easily become a fact of the faith simply taken for granted. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* describes the mystery of the Holy Trinity as the central mystery of the Christian faith and life (see CCC 234). This statement becomes fascinating and awe-inspiring when we take the time, like on Trinity Sunday, and ponder this truth. The Sacred Scriptures and the Liturgical Prayer of the Church clearly illustrate this same truth. Today becomes an opportunity to give renewed praise and glory to our One God, the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This will help us to be more conscious of the meaning of the Sign of the Cross and the profundity of this central mystery of faith.

On Memorial Day, Monday, May 27, 2024, Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 AM in the Cathedral Chapel. The Basilica and the Parish Office will be closed on Memorial Day. Following the 9:00 AM Mass on Memorial Day, everyone is invited to join in praying the Holy Rosary for all those who died in the service of our country.

Next Sunday, June 2, 2024, we observe the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This observance is more popularly known as *Corpus Christi*. The origin of this solemnity was to draw attention to the belief of the Church that the bread and wine become with the Eucharistic Prayer the true and real Body and Blood of Christ. This belief informs our love and devotion for this divine food, reminds us of the need to properly prepare and to reverently receive Holy Communion, to keep the one-hour Communion Fast, and to approach the altar only if we are free from serious sin.

This year our Corpus Christi celebration is part of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage. Archbishop Perez will celebrate the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass which will be followed by a Eucharistic Procession from the Cathedral Basilica to Saint Patrick Church in Rittenhouse Square. The procession will conclude with the Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. A Eucharistic Procession gives public expression to our Catholic Faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. All are welcome to join in this procession! REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

¡Hoy es la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad! ¿Cuántas veces al día hacemos la Señal de la Cruz? Este gesto de profesión de fe en Dios Trino puede ser en muchos casos un gesto bastante rutinario. De hecho, el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad (tres personas igualmente divinas en un solo Dios) puede fácilmente convertirse en un hecho de fe que simplemente se da por sentado. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica describe el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad como el misterio central de la fe y la vida cristiana (ver CIC 234). Esta declaración se vuelve fascinante e inspiradora cuando nos tomamos el tiempo, como el Domingo de la Trinidad, y reflexionamos sobre esta verdad. Las Sagradas Escrituras y la oración litúrgica de la Iglesia ilustran claramente esta misma verdad. Hoy se convierte en una oportunidad para dar renovada alabanza y gloria a nuestro Único Dios, el Padre y el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Esto nos ayudará a ser más conscientes del significado de la Señal de la Cruz y de la profundidad de este misterio central de la fe.

El Día de los Caídos «Memorial Day por su nombre en inglés», el lunes 27 de mayo del 2024, se celebrará misa a las 9:00 AM. en la Capilla de la Catedral. La Basílica y la oficina parroquial estarán cerradas en el Día de los Caídos. El Arzobispo Pérez celebrará la Misa Solemne de las 11:00 AM, seguida de una Procesión Eucarística desde la Catedral Basílica hasta la Iglesia de San Patricio en Rittenhouse Square. La procesión concluirá con la Bendición del Santísimo Sacramento. Una Procesión Eucarística da expresión pública a nuestra Fe Católica en la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. ¡Todos son bienvenidos a unirse a esta procesión! 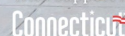
