Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time! We hear in the Gospel for this Sunday (Mark 6: 7-13) that Jesus calls the Twelve Apostles and then sends them out with some authority. Jesus alone is the Savior of the World and brings to us with his death and resurrection our redemption and salvation. Yet, he summons the Apostles to share in his saving mission by sharing his authority with them and sending them out to teach, preach, and heal in his name. In a related way, as his followers, Jesus shares this same saving mission with us. In our own circumstances of family, among our friends and coworkers, we have the duty that comes from our discipleship and reception of the Sacraments, to do whatever we can to make Jesus known - his Word and way of life. Our example goes a long way. At times, though, it may take a conversation, an invitation, a shared prayer, that will advance the Savior's work through us for the sake of others.

This Tuesday, July 16, 2024, is the Memorial of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. This midsummer commemoration of our Blessed Mother is another reminder of how Mary is always near to us ready to come to our aid. The Collect for the Mass of Our Lady of Mount Carmel beautifully illustrates this thought:

May the venerable intercession
of the glorious Virgin Mary
come to our aid, we pray, O Lord,
so that, fortified by her protection,
we may reach the mountain which is Christ.
Who lives and reigns with you in the unity
of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever. Amen.

With this edition of the Parish Bulletin, I introduce to you Sister Marie Faustina, RSM, and Sister Margaret Mary, RSM, as new members of our Parish Staff. Both Sisters are Religious Sisters of Mercy from Alma, Michigan. Sister Marie Faustina will be our part-time Parish Manager, replacing Sister Mary Marta, RSM, who after five wonderful and generous years of service to our Cathedral Parish, has been reassigned to the Cathedral in Saginaw, Michigan. Sister Marie Faustina will also serve the Archdiocese of Philadelphia as the part-time Delegate for Consecrated Life. Sister Margaret Mary will assist Sister Marie Faustina in the Cathedral Parish Office. We welcome both Sisters and look forward to their ministry among us.

The violence in our city, especially the gun violence, is unspeakable. Oftentimes, the shootings are random. Lives are senselessly ended. Families and communities are devastated. And violence frequently begets violence. Many times, we feel helpless in the face of such constant tragedy. One thing that we as Christians can do and must do is to pray. I encourage you to pray each day in an intentional way for an end to violence in our city. *Our Lady, Queen of Peace, pray for us!*

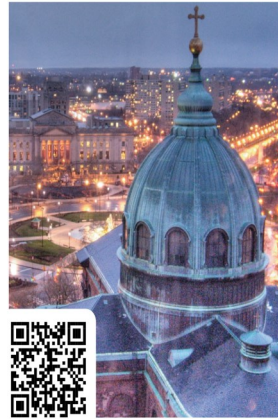

REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

¡Hoy es el décimo quinto domingo del Tiempo Ordinario! Escuchamos en el evangelio de este domingo (Marcos 6: 7-13) que Jesús llama a los Doce Apóstoles y luego los envía con cierta autoridad. Sólo Jesús es el Salvador del mundo y nos trae con su muerte y resurrección nuestra redención y salvación. Sin embargo, convoca a los apóstoles a compartir su misión salvadora compartiendo su autoridad con ellos y enviándolos a enseñar, predicar y sanar en su nombre. De manera relacionada, como sus seguidores, Jesús comparte esta misma misión salvadora con nosotros. En nuestras propias circunstancias de familia, entre nuestros amigos y compañeros de trabajo, tenemos el deber que surge de nuestro discipulado y recepción de los Sacramentos, de hacer todo lo que podamos para dar a conocer a Jesús: su Palabra y su forma de vida. Nuestro ejemplo es muy útil. Sin embargo, a veces puede ser necesaria una conversación, una invitación, una oración compartida que haga avanzar la obra del Salvador a través de nosotros por el bien de los demás.

nuestra Señora del Carmen, para que,
con la ayuda de su protección,
podamos llegar hasta el monte de la salvación,
que es Cristo. El, que vive y reina contigo
en la unidad del Espíritu Santo
y es Dios por los siglos de siglos. Amén.

Cathedral Sacramental Preparation 2024-2025

The Cathedral Parish will offer classes again this coming year for children who need to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

Please remember –

This is NOT a full religious education program.

Your child may attend these classes whether he or she is attending a Catholic school in the Archdiocese, is in a religious education program at another parish, is NOT in religious education, or is in a home-based program.

There will be a section of each class for primarily English-speaking children/families, and another for primarily Spanish-speaking children/families.

Children coming for First Holy Communion preparation will be prepared for the Sacrament of Penance during the fall; after New Year classes will focus on the Holy Eucharist and specific preparation for First Holy Communion. Confirmation preparation will follow the same schedule.
