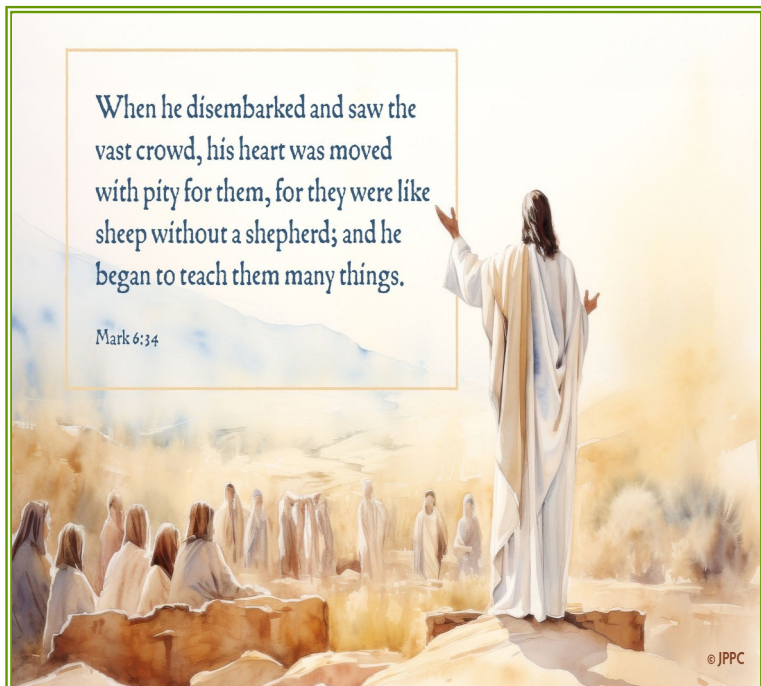

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time! The Gospel for this Sunday (Mark 6: 30-34) manifests the tender and constant love of Jesus for each of us. During his public ministry, the Lord tirelessly gives himself over to his saving mission of teaching his followers and performing all types of healing. When he would see vast crowds before him, "his heart was moved with pity for them." Pity here is to be understood as compassion. The Lord suffered along with those in need. The Lord Jesus continues to suffer along with us in all our needs, especially as he continues to bring us his divine compassion in the announcement of his word and the celebration of his sacraments through his Church. The Lord Jesus also continues to suffer along with us and comes to our aid when we reach out to another in need, when we listen to someone, pray with them and pray for them. All of us can be the face of the tender and loving Jesus before others as he is before each of us. May today's Gospel inspires us to do so.

Father Matthew Carroll, OP, begins his new assignment tomorrow as the Parochial Vicar of our Cathedral Parish. We look forward to Father Carroll's priestly ministry among us and assure him of our prayers. Father's appointment to our Cathedral Parish is historic. As a Dominican priest, he is the first religious priest to be assigned to the Cathedral Parish, rather than a diocesan priest, as a parochial vicar—an assistant pastor. While Father's full time priestly ministry will be the Cathedral Parish, he will live with his religious community, the Dominican Friars (<https://www.stpatrickphilly.org/dominicans.html>), at Saint Patrick's Rectory, Rittenhouse Square. With this edition of the parish bulletin, I want to highlight Gina Ingiosi, our director of religious education. Gina Ingiosi replaces Christian Thompson who assisted us in this role for the past year. Christian provided very fine service to our parish in coordinating the duties and responsibilities of our sacrament preparation program for school age children. Gina assumes this position in conjunction with her role as the associate director of the Shrine of Saint Katharine Drexel. The parish sacrament preparation program is growing both for English and Spanish speaking candidates. Please look for more information from Gina about our program in the parish bulletin and in the monthly e-mail newsletter. If you have a school age child in need of preparation for Confirmation, First Penance and First Holy Communion, please contact Gina Ingiosi directly at gingiosi@archphila.org.

This Monday, July 22, 2024, we remember Saint Mary Magdalene. I encourage you to attend Holy Mass at either 7:15 AM or 12:05 PM in the Cathedral Chapel to celebrate this Feast. We turn to Saint Mary Magdalene to come to our aid to be witnesses to the Resurrection of Jesus like the Apostles. *Saint Mary Magdalene, pray for us!*

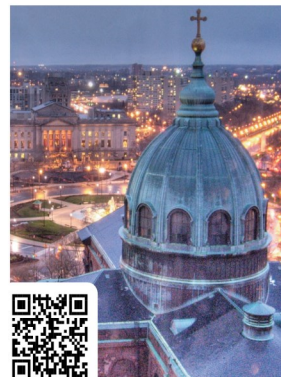

Cathedral Sacramental Preparation 2024-2025

The Cathedral Parish will offer classes again this coming year for children who need to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

Please remember –

This is NOT a full religious education program.

Your child may attend these classes whether he or she is attending a Catholic school in the Archdiocese, is in a religious education program at another parish, is NOT in religious education, or is in a home-based program.

There will be a section of each class for primarily English-speaking children/families, and another for primarily Spanish-speaking children/families.

Children coming for First Holy Communion preparation will be prepared for the Sacrament of Penance during the fall; after New Year classes will focus on the Holy Eucharist and specific preparation for First Holy Communion. Confirmation preparation will follow the same schedule.

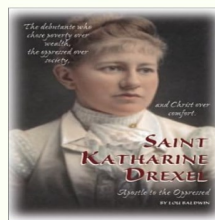
