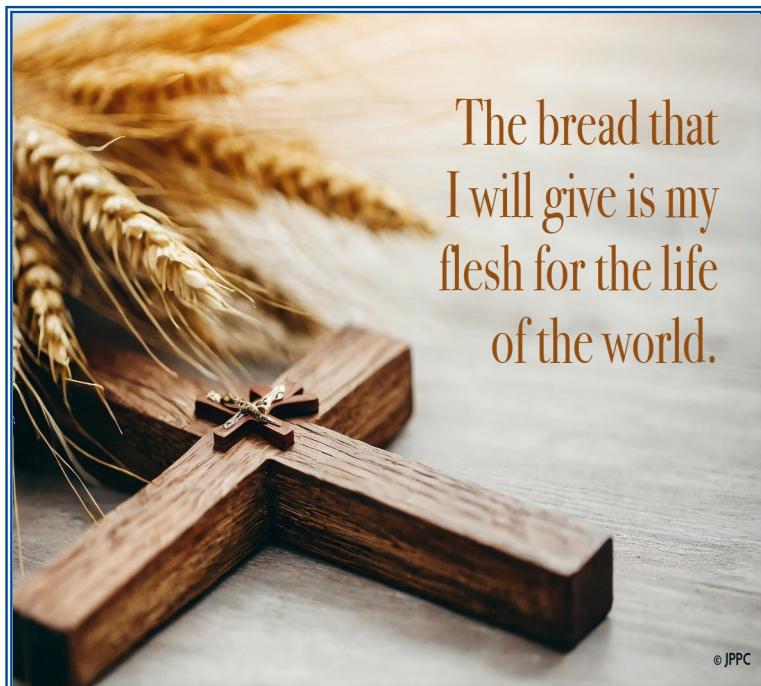

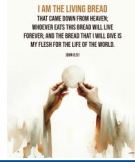

Dear Parishioners,

*Today is the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time!* The Lord Jesus, in this Sunday's Gospel, continues to teach us about his great Gift to us in the Holy Eucharist. The marvel revealed to us over the past few weeks is just what is the Holy Eucharist - the Lord himself! Today, we hear additional good news about this Gift of the Eucharist. "I am the living bread that comes down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world (John 6: 51)." We profess that the Eucharist is truly and really Jesus Christ. With this profession of faith comes a deeper understanding. With our worthy reception of Communion there is a connection with eternal life and the way we are to live our Christian lives. When we receive Holy Communion, we eat and drink of the risen and glorified Lord, the Lord who awaits us at the heavenly banquet. In fact, the Lord gives us his Body and Blood during the Mass from his place in heaven. "Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb" are the words that are part of our invitation to come forward for Holy Communion at each Mass. The Lord who makes us one in his Body with Holy Communion compels us to recognize him and serve him in one another. Let us hear in this teaching of Jesus a necessary reminder to express our own personal love and devotion for the Holy Eucharist. Let us also be sincere to receive Holy Communion without serious sin and ready to live from all the blessings and graces that come to us from the Lord.

*This Thursday, August 15, 2024, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation.* This observance fills us with the hope that what is Mary's eternal glory may one day come to each of us as well in the death and resurrection of her Divine Son. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, as a Holy Day of Obligation, requires us to participate in Mass and to conduct ourselves throughout the day as much as possible like a Sunday. For many, this Thursday is a typical workday and therefore brings a challenge to observe the Holy Day as the Church intends. Yet, it is possible in most cases with some effort to rearrange schedules to participate at Holy Mass and to be mindful of the heavenly help of Mary to pray for us as we strive to live the Christian life. Please see the Mass and Confession schedule for the Holy Day elsewhere in the parish bulletin.

*Once again, please see elsewhere in this edition of the Parish Bulletin information on the preparation for the Sacraments - Confirmation, Penance and Reconciliation, and First Holy Communion - for school age children.* Please do not delay in contacting Gina Ingiosi, [gingiosi@archphila.org](mailto:gingiosi@archphila.org), our Cathedral Parish Director of Religious Education, for enrollment in this preparation program. This program is conducted in English and Spanish.

## REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

*¡Hoy es el Décimo noveno Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario!* El Señor Jesús, en el evangelio de este domingo, continúa enseñándonos acerca de su gran regalo para nosotros en la Sagrada Eucaristía. La maravilla que se nos ha revelado durante las últimas semanas es precisamente lo que es la Sagrada Eucaristía: ¡el Señor mismo! Hoy escuchamos buenas noticias adicionales sobre este regalo de la Eucaristía. “Yo soy el pan vivo que ha bajado del cielo; el que come este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo les voy a dar es mi carne para que el mundo tenga la vida (Juan 6: 51)”. Profesamos que la Eucaristía es verdadera y realmente Jesucristo. Con esta profesión de fe viene una comprensión más profunda. Con nuestra digna recepción de la Comunión hay una conexión con la vida eterna y la forma en que debemos vivir nuestra vida cristiana. Cuando recibimos la Sagrada Comunión, comemos y bebemos del Señor resucitado y glorificado, el Señor que nos espera en el banquete celestial. De hecho, el Señor nos entrega su Cuerpo y Sangre durante la Misa desde su lugar en el cielo. “Bienaventurados los llamados a la cena del Cordero” son las palabras que forman parte de nuestra invitación a pasar al frente para recibir la Sagrada Comunión en cada Misa. El Señor que nos hace uno en su Cuerpo con la Sagrada Comunión nos obliga a reconocerlo y servirle. él el uno en el otro. Escuchemos en esta enseñanza de Jesús un recordatorio necesario para expresar nuestro amor y devoción personal por la Sagrada Eucaristía. Seamos también sinceros para recibir la Sagrada Comunión sin pecado grave y dispuestos a vivir de todas las bendiciones y gracias que nos llegan del Señor.

*Este jueves 15 de agosto del 2024 es la Solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María, Día de Precepto u Obligación.* Esta observancia nos llena de esperanza de que la gloria eterna de María algún día llegue también a cada uno de nosotros en la muerte y resurrección de su Divino Hijo. La Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María, como día de precepto, requiere que participemos en la Misa y nos conduzcamos durante todo el día lo más posible como un domingo. The Cathedral Parish will offer classes again this coming year for children who need to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. Please remember –

This is NOT a full religious education program.

Your child may attend these classes whether he or she is attending a Catholic school in the Archdiocese, is in a religious education program at another parish, is NOT in religious education, or is in a home-based program.

There will be a section of each class for primarily English-speaking children/families, and another for primarily Spanish-speaking children/families.

Children coming for First Holy Communion preparation will be prepared for the Sacrament of Penance during the fall; after New Year classes will focus on the Holy Eucharist and specific preparation for First Holy Communion. Confirmation preparation will follow the same schedule.

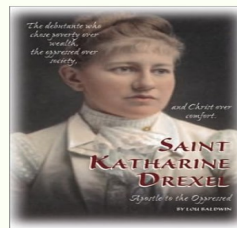
