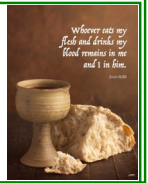

Dear Parishioners,

*Today is the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time! Once again, this Sunday, as we listen to chapter six of the Gospel of Saint John and the Lord's teaching on the Holy Eucharist, Jesus declares that his flesh is true food, and his blood is true drink. The Lord continues that to eat and drink of him is to remain in him and have eternal life. This is an amazing teaching of the Lord and his Church! The Holy Eucharist is the Lord Jesus Christ. Yes, the Holy Eucharist is the Body and Blood, soul and divinity of the Savior, whole and complete. This teaching that comes from the Lord himself requires more than just acceptance in our minds but an acceptance with our lives of faith. If we truly believe this, then we live it, we act out of it and have confidence in it. To receive the Lord himself in Holy Communion is to approach Holy Communion with faith and understanding, to realize that we become what we receive and have the grace and strength to follow the Lord now so as to long to be with him in heaven. The Saints have shown us this Eucharistic way of living the Christian life. We can do the same today. I encourage you to pray the Eucharistic Prayer in your hearts along with the priest, to listen especially to the words of the prayers of the Communion Rite and the Prayer after Communion. These texts inform us of what we believe about Holy Communion and help us to respond in our Christian lives with the help of so great a gift. *O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise, and all thanksgiving be every moment thine!**

In just a few weeks, we will resume our weekly Thursday evening catechetical sessions which are intended primarily for the adults in our community seeking Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. The first session will be on Thursday, September 5, 2024, from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM in the Neumann Room, directly behind the Cathedral Basilica. If you are already a fully initiated member of the Church and the catechetical topic listed in the parish bulletin interests you, please come. Everyone is welcome! If you are an adult with a desire to receive the Sacraments of Christian Initiation - Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, please contact me. We already have a number of adults ready to join us for our first session. Also, we are always in need of parish sponsors - or mentors - for these adults seeking the Sacraments. If this important and good work interests you, please contact me at fr.dgill@archphila.org.

Estimados feligreses,

¡Hoy es el vigésimo domingo del Tiempo Ordinario! Una vez más, este domingo, mientras escuchamos el capítulo seis del evangelio de San Juan y la enseñanza del Señor sobre la Sagrada Eucaristía, Jesús declara que su carne es verdadera comida y su sangre es verdadera bebida. El Señor continúa diciendo que comer y beber de él es permanecer en él y tener vida eterna. ¡Esta es una enseñanza asombrosa del Señor y su Iglesia! La Sagrada Eucaristía es el Señor Jesucristo. Sí, la Sagrada Eucaristía es el Cuerpo y la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad del Salvador, entero y completo. Cathedral Sacramental Preparation 2024-2025

The Cathedral Parish will offer classes again this coming year for children who need to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

Please remember –

This is NOT a full religious education program.

Your child may attend these classes whether he or she is attending a Catholic school in the Archdiocese, is in a religious education program at another parish, is NOT in religious education, or is in a home-based program.

There will be a section of each class for primarily English-speaking children/families, and another for primarily Spanish-speaking children/families.

Children coming for First Holy Communion preparation will be prepared for the Sacrament of Penance during the fall; after New Year classes will focus on the Holy Eucharist and specific preparation for First Holy Communion. Confirmation preparation will follow the same schedule.

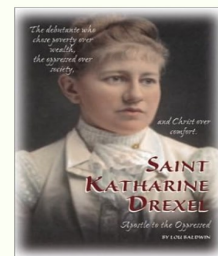

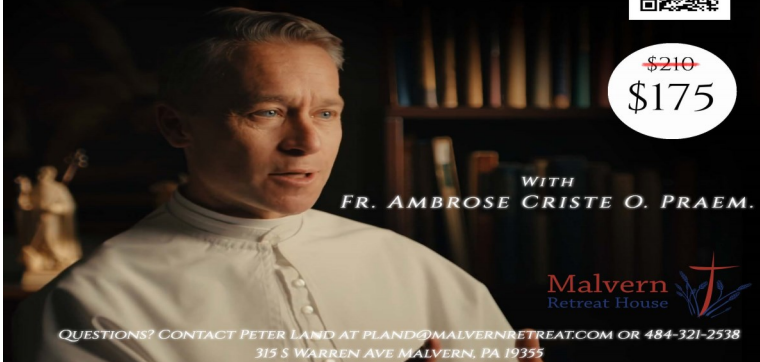
