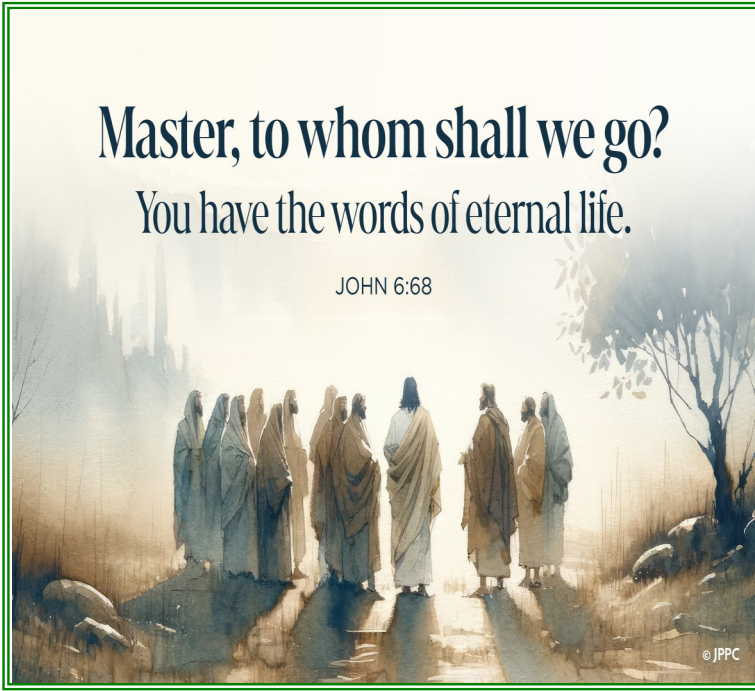

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time! Jesus, after weeks of teaching us about his great gift of the Holy Eucharist in the Gospel of John, that he is the true Bread from Heaven, his Flesh is true food and his Blood true drink, hears his disciples in this Sunday's Gospel remark, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" As the Gospel relates some of the disciples did believe and continued to accompany him and others choose not to believe and accompanied him no longer. This invitation to believe the Lord's words about the Holy Eucharist was not only for the first band of followers in the Gospel. This same "hard saying" is for us to accept every time we come to Mass, every time we hear the priest give us the invitation to Holy Communion, "Behold the Lamb of God." For us to accept the teaching of Jesus about his Holy Eucharist, that it is no longer bread and wine but really and truly his holy Body and Blood, is also to make the choice to continue to accompany him, to know his way of life and keep his commandments. This goes hand in hand. As the Lord also teaches us in this same section of the Gospel to eat his Body and drink his Blood is to have his live within us and to live forever. The grace, power and strength of Holy Communion worthily received is to have all that we need to faithfully follow Jesus through this life and to be with him one day in glory. Today's Gospel reminds us to never allow ourselves to be routine or tepid with our reception of Holy Communion. Rather, may we always receive the Lord with a sincere act of faith in the Bread that comes down from Heaven, Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Next Sunday, September 1, 2024, at the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass, we will commemorate the great blessing to the Church of the Consecrated Life. All baptized Christians live a life consecrated to the Lord to follow his Gospel way of life. Religious men and women live the Consecrated Life in a more profound way with the evangelical counsels, vows, of chastity, poverty and obedience. Next Sunday concludes the Golden Jubilee of the Institute of the Religious Sisters of Mercy of Alma, Michigan, which gives us the occasion for our celebration. We are so grateful at the Cathedral Parish for the service of the Religious Sisters of Mercy of Alma among us and pray on this occasion for many blessings for their Institute.

Also, next Sunday, September 1, 2024, marks the annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Pope Francis established this observance in 2015 following a similar observance in the Eastern Church. The created world points to the majesty and providence of Almighty God and how he has entrusted to us stewardship over all the earth. We do not have to look too far to see how creation in every form suffers from neglect and abuse of all types. As we pray for the care of creation, it prompts us to action and reminds us that our primary care must be directed to the crown of creation, human life, from the first moment of conception until natural death. Please join this intention to your personal prayers next Sunday.

Please keep the intention for peace in our city and an end to gun violence in our neighborhoods in your prayers. Our Lady, Queen of Peace, pray for us!

Thank you to all our parishioners and visitors for your goodness and generosity to the Cathedral Parish. The second collection next Sunday will be directed to the support of the poor and needy in the neighborhood of the Cathedral Parish. REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos feligreses,

¡Hoy es el vigésimo primer domingo del Tiempo Ordinario! Jesús, después de semanas de enseñarnos acerca de su gran regalo de la Sagrada Eucaristía en el evangelio de Juan, que él es el verdadero Pan del Cielo, su Carne es verdadero alimento y su Sangre verdadera bebida, escucha a sus discípulos en el evangelio de este domingo comentar: “Este modo de hablar es intolerante, ¿quién puede admitir eso? Como relata el evangelio algunos de los discípulos sí creyeron y continuaron acompañándolo y otros optaron por no creer y ya no lo acompañaron. Esta invitación a creer las palabras del Señor sobre la Sagrada Eucaristía no fue solo para el primer grupo de seguidores del evangelio. Este mismo “modo intolerante” debemos aceptarlo cada vez que venimos a Misa, cada vez que escuchamos al sacerdote darnos la invitación a la Sagrada Comunión: “He aquí el Cordero de Dios”. Para nosotros aceptar la enseñanza de Jesús sobre su Sagrada Eucaristía, de que ya no es pan y vino sino real y verdaderamente su santo Cuerpo y Sangre, es también elegir seguir acompañándolo, conocer su estilo de vida y guardar sus mandamientos. Esto va de la mano. Como también nos enseña el Señor en esta misma sección del evangelio, comer su Cuerpo y beber su Sangre es tener su vida dentro de nosotros y vivir para siempre. La gracia, el poder y la fuerza de la Sagrada Comunión recibida dignamente es tener todo lo que necesitamos para seguir fielmente a Jesús a lo largo de esta vida y estar con él un día en gloria. El evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que nunca debemos permitirnos ser rutinarios o tibios al recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Más bien, que recibamos siempre al Señor con un acto sincero de fe en el Pan que desciende del Cielo, Jesucristo, nuestro Señor.

El próximo domingo 1 de septiembre del 2024, en la Misa Solemne de las 11:00 AM, conmemoraremos la gran bendición a la Iglesia de la Vida Consagrada. Todos los cristianos bautizados viven una vida consagrada al Señor para seguir su estilo de vida evangélico. Los religiosos y religiosas viven de manera más profunda la Vida Consagrada con los consejos evangélicos, los votos, la castidad, la pobreza y la obediencia. El próximo domingo concluye el Jubileo de Oro del Instituto de las Religiosas Hermanas de la Misericordia de Alma, Michigan, lo que nos brinda la ocasión para nuestra celebración. Estamos muy agradecidos en la Parroquia Catedral por el servicio de las Religiosas Hermanas de la Misericordia de Alma entre nosotros y oramos en esta ocasión por muchas bendiciones para su Instituto.

Además, el próximo domingo 1 de septiembre del 2024 se celebra la Jornada Mundial Anual de Oración por el Cuidado de la Creación. El Papa Francisco estableció esta observancia en el 2015 luego de una observancia similar en la Iglesia Oriental. El mundo creado señala la majestad y la providencia de Dios Todopoderoso y cómo él nos ha confiado la mayordomía sobre toda la tierra. No tenemos que mirar demasiado lejos para ver cómo la creación en todas sus formas sufre negligencia y abuso de todo tipo. Cuando oramos por el cuidado de la creación, nos impulsa a actuar y nos recuerda que nuestro cuidado principal debe dirigirse a la corona de la creación, la vida humana, desde el primer momento de la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Por favor unan esta intención a sus oraciones personales el próximo domingo.

Por favor mantengan en sus oraciones la intención de lograr la paz en nuestra ciudad y el fin de la violencia armada en nuestros vecindarios. ¡Nuestra Señora, Reina de la Paz, ruega por nosotros!

Cathedral Sacramental Preparation 2024-2025

The Cathedral Parish will offer classes again this coming year for children who need to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

Please remember –

This is NOT a full religious education program.

Your child may attend these classes whether he or she is attending a Catholic school in the Archdiocese, is in a religious education program at another parish, is NOT in religious education, or is in a home-based program.

There will be a section of each class for primarily English-speaking children/families, and another for primarily Spanish-speaking children/families.

Children coming for First Holy Communion preparation will be prepared for the Sacrament of Penance during the fall; after New Year classes will focus on the Holy Eucharist and specific preparation for First Holy Communion. Confirmation preparation will follow the same schedule.

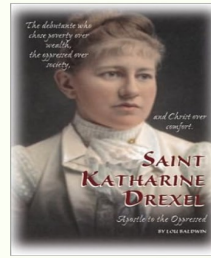
