And O what transport of delight from thy pure chalice floweth.

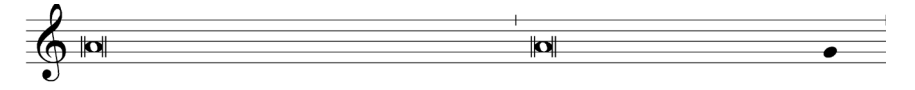
