Dear Parishioners,

This is the Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Holy Gospel for this Sunday invites us to be merciful as our heavenly Father is merciful (see Luke 6:36) and accordingly directs our relationships with one another. We are charged to convert from sinful and selfish ways with regard to our neighbors and to love one another in more just and generous ways. This Gospel call to conversion will receive a greater impetus for all of us with the beginning of Lent on Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2025. Our Lord's plea to reform our lives according to his example and with his grace is a year-round Christian duty as we hear today. The upcoming Lent gives us the opportunity to be more focused, more intentional, in our penance for our failure to be merciful with one another and, with the help of Christ himself, to be merciful like the Father of us all.

Lent is around the corner! Please see the insert in this edition of the parish bulletin that includes the regulations for Friday abstinence from meat and fasting during Lent, the Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday, the times for Confession, and the other ways our Cathedral Parish provides for the observance of Lent 2025. These days ahead of Ash Wednesday give us the opportunity to consider seriously keeping a good Lent. In addition to what is available at the Cathedral Parish, you might consider planning to read a spiritual book and/or parts of the Bible, attending daily Mass, making a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament one day a week, finding a way to help the poor and needy as part of a fruitful observance of Lent. *Baskets will be at the entrances to the Basilica for this Sunday and next for your old blessed palm.*

The Feast of Saint Katharine Drexel is Monday, March 3, 2025. There will be a solemn celebration of Mass on this day at the 12:05 PM Mass in the Basilica. Plan now to join us for this celebration of the Feast. Saint Katharine Drexel, pray for us!

I encourage you to give the gift of a Mass offered for your family and your friends, living and dead. The priest celebrant, when he makes his intention to offer Mass, includes the particular intention of the Mass. We print every week in the parish bulletin the Mass Intentions for the upcoming week so that these same intentions will be also remembered in the prayers of all who read them and especially by those who attend the scheduled Mass. It is also possible to have an unannounced Mass offered for a particular intention. These Masses are offered by the parish priests at unscheduled times. To have a Mass offered for a particular intention, please contact the Parish Office. It is also possible to arrange for an unannounced Mass in the Cathedral Sacristy.

LENTEN SCHEDULE

The holy season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes on Holy Thursday with the celebration of the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. Lent is a preparation for the celebration of Easter. The Lenten liturgy disposes both catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery, the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus. For catechumens, this takes place through the several stages of Christian initiation. For the faithful, this takes place through reminders of their own baptism and through penitential practices.

COLLECTION OF OLD BLESSED PALM

You are invited to bring your old blessed palm to church today, **Sunday, February 23 and Sunday, March 2**. Please place it in the baskets near the sanctuary. This palm will be burned for the ashes for Ash Wednesday. You may also reverently dispose of your blessed palm by burning it and burying it at home.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT AND FASTING DURING LENT

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, *as a minimal obligation*, that all persons who are **fourteen years of age and older** are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. Keeping a voluntary fast throughout Lent is encouraged on the part of all.

CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The description and schedule of the Lenten Rites for the Elect (catechumens) and Candidates for the Easter Sacraments will be announced in the Parish Bulletin all throughout Lent. These rites will take place at the **Saturday evening 5:15 PM Anticipated Mass** for Sunday and at the **Sunday 11:00 AM Solemn Mass**.

In addition to the celebration of Mass with the distribution of Ashes, there will be Celebrations of the Word of God and the distribution of Ashes in the medical facilities within the parish boundaries on Ash Wednesday.


