Dear Parishioners,

This is the Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Sunday before Lent. Over the last few Sundays, the Lord has instructed us through the Gospel of Luke on what it means to be his intentional disciple—following him today in a committed and consistent manner. This Sunday continues with this instruction. Such faithfulness to the way of Lord, a life oriented to the love of God and neighbor, brings about a truly converted heart. “A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks” (Luke 6: 45). A converted heart is the everyday work of conversion supported by the grace of Christ. Lent offers us the opportunity to commit more fully to this Christian duty of conversion—turning away from sin and believing in the Gospel. Prompted by this Sunday’s Gospel and with Lent days away, take some time to reflect on practical and real ways to provide for a converted heart, a heart that produces good.

Lent begins this Wednesday, Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2025, a universal day of fasting and abstinence. Please see the schedule for Masses and the distribution of blessed ashes on Ash Wednesday elsewhere in this edition of the parish bulletin. Commit now to a good Lent. A personal plan for the observance of Lent moves beyond the minimal obligations of fasting and abstinence. Our plan should also include occasions for more prayer, additional fasting, and taking care of the poor. Let us pray for one another for a good Lent. Please take note of the insert for the many opportunities to observe Lent here at the Cathedral Basilica.

*We celebrate the Feast of Saint Katharine Drexel this Monday, March 3, 2025. The principal celebration of her feast will be the sung Mass at 12:05 PM in the Basilica. *Next weekend with the First Sunday of Lent Catechumens from all throughout the Archdiocese of Philadelphia will be elected for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist to be received at the Easter Vigil. Our parish catechumens will participate in the Rite of Election of Catechumens on Sunday afternoon, March 9, 2025, at 3:00 PM. They will be exhorted, with the help of our prayers and example, to observe Lent as a time of purification and enlightenment and to look forward to their Christian Initiation at Easter. Once the Catechumens are elected for the Easter Sacraments, they are no longer called Catechumens but the Elect. We also have a good number of baptized Christians in the Cathedral Parish preparing to come into the Church and/or to receive Confirmation and Holy Communion during Easter Time. They, along with other Candidates from all throughout the Archdiocese, will also join the Catechumens and be exhorted to remain steadfast in their continuing conversion to Christ during Lent. Please keep all our Catechumens and Candidates in your prayers. *You are most welcome to attend the Rite of Election of Catechumens and of Calling the Candidates to Continuing Conversion next Sunday afternoon.**

Thank you to all our parishioners and visitors for your goodness and generosity to the Cathedral Parish and to the Annual Catholic Charities Appeal. The second collection next Sunday will be directed to the national collection for the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Latin America. REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Este es el octavo domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, el domingo anterior a la Cuaresma. Durante los últimos domingos, el Señor nos ha instruido a través del evangelio de Lucas sobre lo que significa ser su discípulo intencional, siguiéndolo hoy de manera comprometida y consistente. Este domingo continúa con esta instrucción. Tal fidelidad al camino del Señor, una vida orientada al amor de Dios y al prójimo, produce un corazón verdaderamente convertido. “El hombre bueno dice cosas buenas, porque el bien está en su corazón, y el hombre malo dice cosas malas, porque el mal está en su corazón, pues la boca habla de lo que está lleno el corazón” (Lc. 6, 45). Un corazón convertido es el trabajo diario de conversión apoyado por la gracia de Cristo. La Cuaresma nos ofrece la oportunidad de comprometernos más plenamente con este deber cristiano de conversión: alejarnos del pecado y creer en el evangelio. Impulsados por el evangelio de este domingo y con los días de Cuaresma a la vuelta de la esquina, tómese un tiempo para reflexionar sobre formas prácticas y reales de proveer para un corazón convertido, un corazón que produzca el bien.

La Cuaresma comienza este miércoles, Miércoles de Ceniza, 5 de marzo del 2025, día universal de ayuno y abstinencia. LENTEN SCHEDULE

The holy season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes on Holy Thursday with the celebration of the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. Lent is a preparation for the celebration of Easter. The Lenten liturgy disposes both catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery, the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus. For catechumens, this takes place through the several stages of Christian initiation. For the faithful, this takes place through reminders of their own baptism and through penitential practices.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT AND FASTING DURING LENT

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, *as a minimal obligation*, that all persons who are **fourteen years of age and older** are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. Keeping a voluntary fast throughout Lent is encouraged on the part of all.

CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The description and schedule of the Lenten Rites for the Elect (catechumens) and Candidates for the Easter Sacraments will be announced in the Parish Bulletin all throughout Lent. These rites will take place at the **Saturday evening 5:15 PM Anticipated Mass** for Sunday and at the **Sunday 11:00 AM Solemn Mass**.

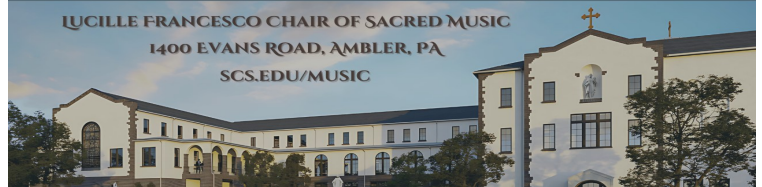
