

Dear Parishioners.

Today is Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord and the beginning of Holy Week. This week we have the unique opportunity to celebrate and to live out in a rather complete way the mysteries of our redemption and salvation with the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy. This is the greatest week of the Church Year. Plan to participate in the Sacred Paschal Triduum. Please see the schedule for Holy Week and the Sacred Paschal Triduum elsewhere in this edition of the Parish Bulletin. Also, please take note of the additional opportunities for the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation during Holy Week and the Sacred Paschal Triduum in the Cathedral Basilica. Don't miss the opportunity to make a good Confession for Easter!

Please take the blessed palm that you receive at Mass today and place it over the crucifix that hangs in your home. The blessed palm, as it reminds us during the Palm Sunday Mass, is a sign all throughout the year of the victory of Christ, the Redeemer, over sin and death with his Cross and Resurrection. Any old, blessed palm can be brought to the Cathedral Sacristy at any time for its use for ashes next Ash Wednesday. You can also bury or burn your old, blessed palm to dispose properly of it.

All parishioners are welcome to the Chrism Mass on Holy Thursday morning, April 17, 2025, at 10:00 AM. The Chrism Mass is the occasion for the Archbishop to assemble with his priests for the renewal of their Ordination Promises as well as the blessing and consecration of the Holy Oils used in the celebration of the sacramental rites of the Church. Please keep all priests in your prayers on Holy Thursday, the anniversary of the institution of the Priesthood by the Lord.


