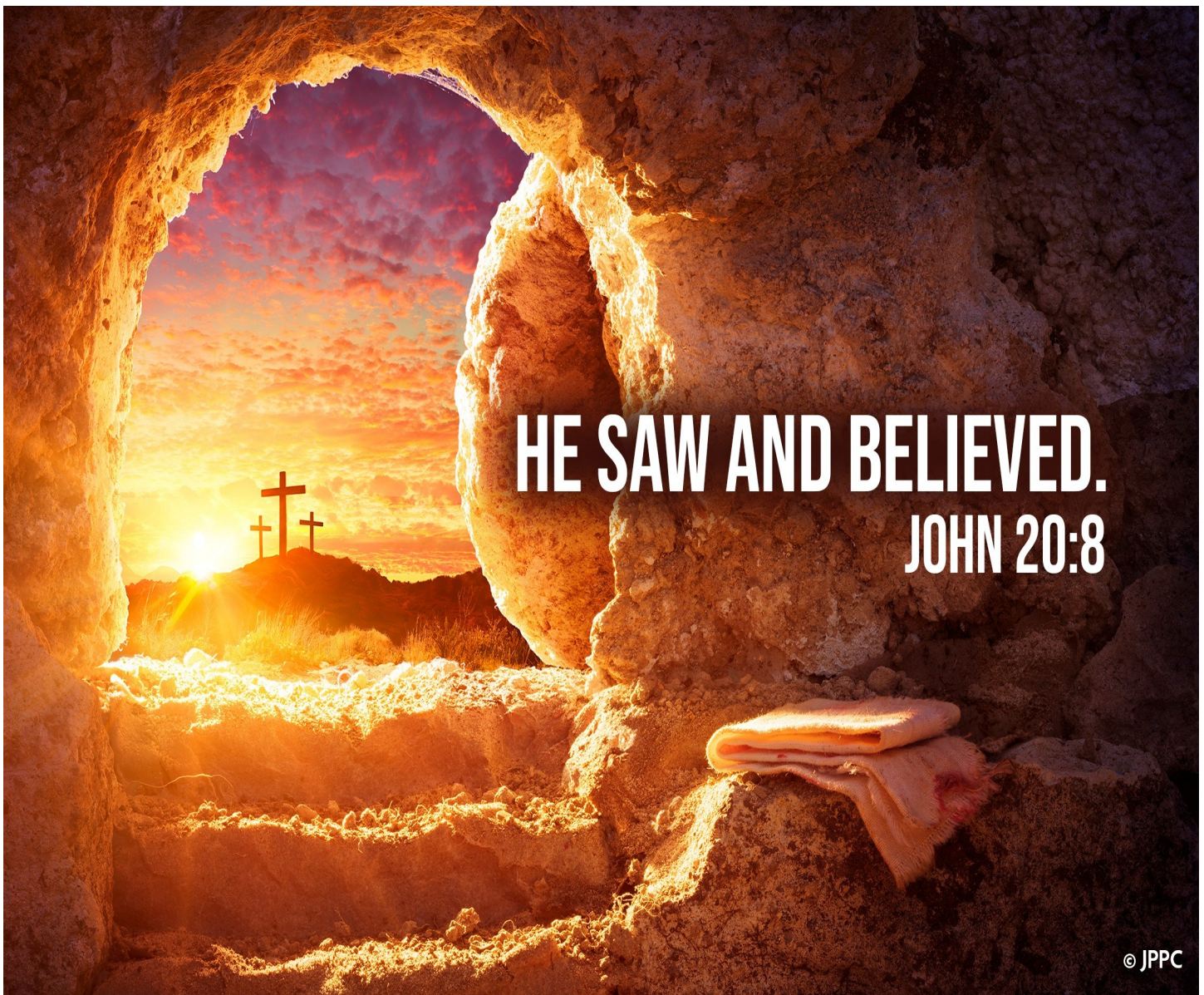

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter to all our parishioners and visitors! May the Risen Lord fill you with his peace! May our response to the Risen Lord be Christian lives of fidelity and joy! In the Gospel for this Easter Sunday, we hear how Saint John, the apostle of the Lord, enters the empty tomb where Jesus was buried. He sees and believes. We truly do believe that Jesus who died on the cross for us to save us from our sins is risen from the dead. This mystery of the resurrection of Jesus happened once and is for all time and into eternity. It is for us, like the apostle, to see with the eyes of faith and believe firmly that our Savior and Redeemer is alive today. Our belief in the resurrection is at once personal and united to the faith of the whole Church. As we renew our belonging to Christ and his Church this Easter in our Baptism and the reception of Holy Communion, may we persevere in a holy way of living and draw others to believe in the Risen Lord.

The celebration of the Easter Sacraments—Baptism, Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist—reveals the grace and power of the Resurrection in a most unique way. It is for this reason that the Church prefers that these Sacraments, especially for adults, take place during Easter Time. Our Cathedral Parish Elect were fully initiated—with Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist—into the Church at the great Easter Vigil. All throughout Easter Time, adults who have already been baptized as non-Catholics will be received into full communion with the Catholic Church with the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist. Likewise, all throughout Easter Time, adults who have been baptized as Catholics will be confirmed and receive their first Holy Communion. Our school age candidates will be confirmed by Bishop McIntyre next Sunday, April 27, 2025, at the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass. Our school age candidates will receive their first Holy Communion on Sunday, May 4, 2025, at the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass. Please remember all these candidates for the Easter Sacraments in your prayers.

We are encouraged to begin our Lent with resolutions to help us repent and believe more fervently in the Gospel. This is so that we might renew our baptismal promises to the Lord with a firm heart at Easter and be even more intentional in living the Christian life. However, often with Easter we do not make any such resolutions to participate in the Fifty Days of Easter. I encourage you today to make one Easter resolution. Easter is the season of the Holy Eucharist. Examine your own commitment to Sunday Mass and to keeping holy the whole of the Lord's Day. Come to Mass during the week. Spend some time in adoration of the Lord in the tabernacle. The Acts of the Apostles is the book of the Bible that tells us how the early Christians lived the mystery of the Risen Lord. Reflectively reading this section of the Bible helps us today to do the same. Take some extra time in the morning or evening for quiet prayer in your home. Turn to Mary, especially in her Rosary, to pray with her the mysteries of her Son's life and our salvation. Again, I encourage you to make one Easter resolution.

En el evangelio de este Domingo de Pascua de Resurrección, escuchamos cómo San Juan, el apóstol del Señor, entra en el sepulcro vacío donde Jesús fue enterrado. Él ve y cree. Creemos firmemente que Jesús, quien murió en la cruz por nosotros para salvarnos de nuestros pecados, resucitó de entre los muertos. Este misterio de la resurrección de Jesús sucedió una vez y es para siempre y por la eternidad. Nos corresponde, como al apóstol, ver con los ojos de la fe y creer firmemente que nuestro Salvador y Redentor vive hoy. Nuestra creencia en la resurrección es a la vez personal y está unida a la fe de toda la Iglesia. 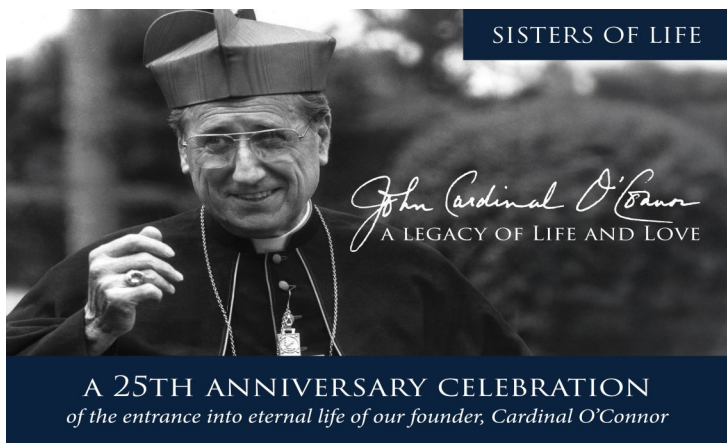

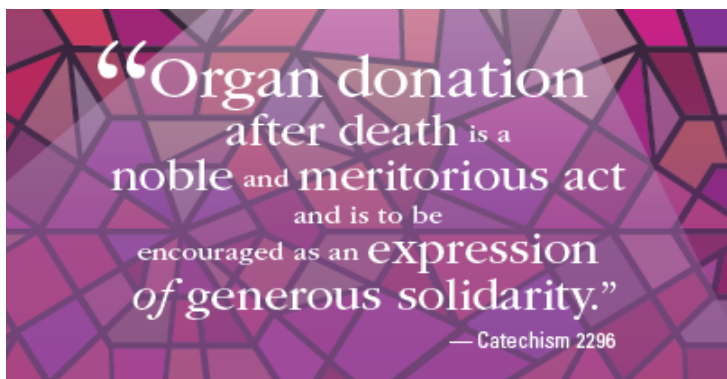
