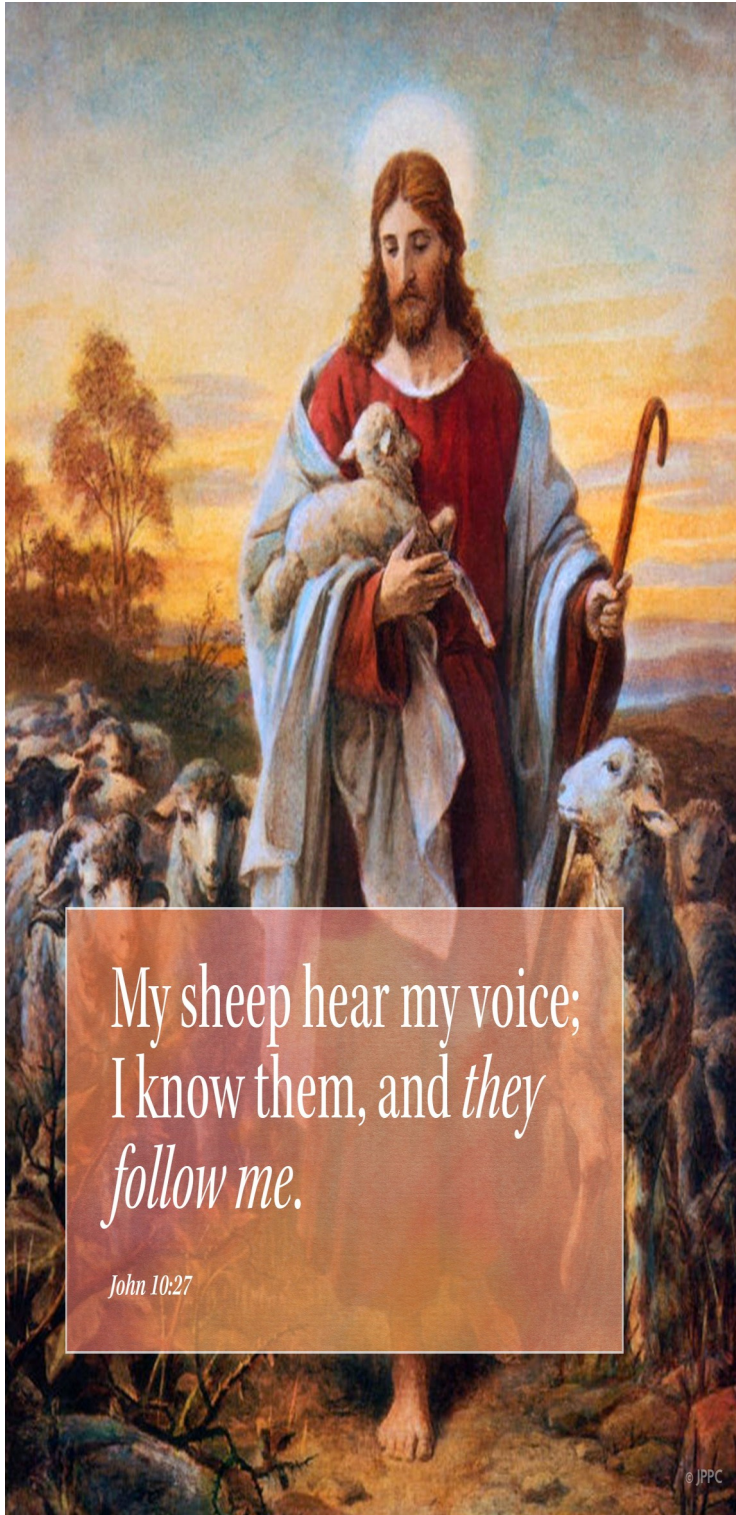

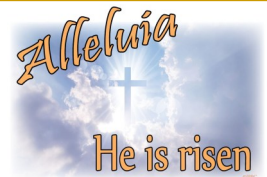

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter, Good Shepherd Sunday. In the Holy Gospel for this Sunday, the Good Shepherd, the Risen Lord, speaks a comforting word to us. "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish (John 10: 27-28)." Participation in Spiritual Formation

- Attend popular missions, spiritual exercises, or formation activities focused on:

The documents of the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of the Catholic Church

For Those Unable to Participate in Person

The elderly, sick, imprisoned, or others unable to attend in person may still obtain the Jubilee Indulgence under the same conditions if, united in spirit with those participating, they:

- Follow celebrations through available media (broadcasts by the Pope or their diocesan bishop).
- Recite the Our Father, the Profession of Faith (in any approved form), and other prayers reflecting the spirit of the Holy Year.
- Offer up their sufferings or hardships as a spiritual sacrifice.
