Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Fifth Sunday of Easter! The Risen Lord manifests himself to us in a great number of ways. The most excellent manifestation of the Risen Lord takes place with the celebration of Mass, the Holy Eucharist. When the bread and wine, through the invocation of the Holy Spirit and with the Last Supper words of Christ spoken by the priest, become the Holy Body and Blood of the Lord, it is Easter-Christ on the cross and risen from the dead. We rejoice in the providence of God that he has blessed the Church with such a wonderful universal pastor and shepherd. We have a duty to pray for the Vicar of Christ that he will be sustained by divine grace to carry out his many responsibilities to the Church and the world. God bless Pope Leo XIV!


