

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. It may seem odd that a Sunday of the Church Year would be given over to celebrate the Mystery of the Holy Trinity, one God in three equal divine Persons, the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity is the central Mystery of the Christian faith and life. Yet, this Mystery often receives little reflection and consideration from many of us. In fact, this Mystery is at the heart of every celebration of the Eucharist. The Sacrifice of Christ is made present and offered to the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit unites all of us to this same Sacrifice and so brings us intimately into the communion and life of the Holy Trinity. So, this Solemnity gives us pause to be aware of this great Mystery and our everyday participation in it—with all the Sacraments and how we live each day. All comes from and returns to the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit.

Today is also Father's Day. As we pray for our own fathers today, we are reminded how significant this vocation is for all children. Fathers need our encouragement today as they lead their families in the ways of faith. This aspect of fatherhood needs renewed attention and support on the part of all of us.

Next Sunday, June 22, 2025, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, popularly known as Corpus Christi. The origins of this observance promoted the public expression of the biblical and apostolic faith of the Church in the Eucharist. The bread and wine at Mass truly become the Holy Body and Blood of Jesus in a substantial way. We need the same public expression of our faith today. We will observe the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ here at the Cathedral Basilica with an outdoor procession immediately following the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass. This procession will move to Saint Patrick Church at 20th and Locust Streets and conclude there with Benediction. All are welcome to join this Eucharistic Procession.

REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Hoy es la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Puede parecer extraño que un domingo del año eclesiástico se dedique a celebrar el Misterio de la Santísima Trinidad, un solo Dios en tres personas divinas iguales: el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. La Santísima Trinidad es el Misterio central de la fe y la vida cristiana. Sin embargo, a menudo muchos de nosotros reflexionamos poco sobre este misterio. De hecho, este misterio está en el corazón de cada celebración de la Eucaristía. El Sacrificio de Cristo se hace presente y se ofrece al Padre por el poder del Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu Santo nos une a todos a este mismo Sacrificio y nos introduce íntimamente en la comunión y la vida de la Santísima Trinidad. Por ello, esta Solemnidad nos invita a reflexionar sobre este gran misterio y a nuestra participación diaria en él, con todos los sacramentos y nuestra forma de vivir cada día. Todo viene del Padre y regresa a él, por el Hijo, en el Espíritu Santo.

Hoy también es el Día del Padre. Al orar hoy por nuestros padres, recordamos la importancia de esta vocación para todos los hijos. Los padres necesitan nuestro aliento hoy mientras guían a sus familias en el camino de la fe. Este aspecto de la paternidad requiere una renovada atención y apoyo por parte de todos nosotros.

El próximo domingo 22 de junio del 2025 se celebra la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, conocida popularmente como Corpus Christi. Los orígenes de esta celebración promovieron la expresión pública de la fe bíblica y apostólica de la iglesia en la Eucaristía. El pan y el vino en la Misa se convierten en el Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesús de manera sustancial. Necesitamos esta misma expresión pública de nuestra fe hoy. Celebraremos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo aquí en la Catedral Basílica con una procesión al aire libre inmediatamente después de la Misa Solemne de las 11:00 AM. Esta procesión se trasladará a la Iglesia de San Patricio, en las calles 20 y Locust, y concluirá allí con la Benedicción. Todos están invitados a unirse a esta Procesión Eucarística.


