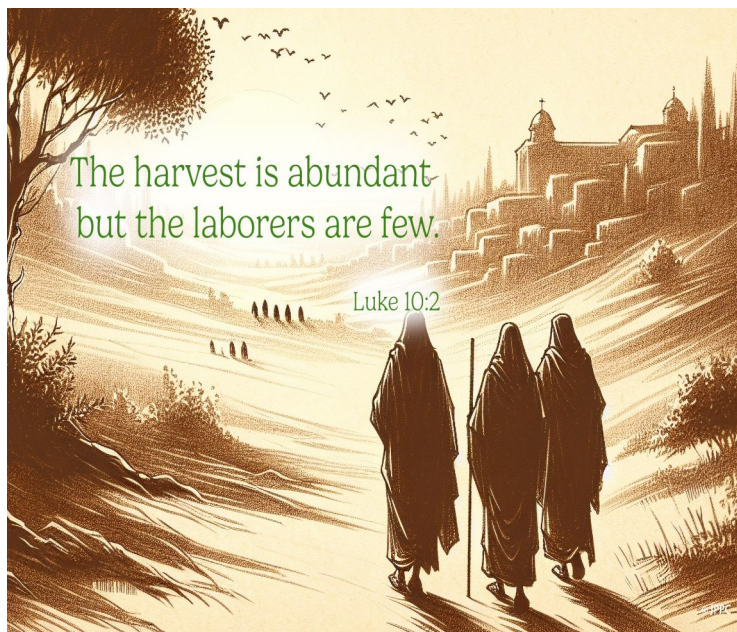

Dear Parishioners,

*Today is the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.* In the Gospel for this Sunday, we hear how the Lord Jesus sent seventy-two disciples ahead of him to the towns and places he intended to visit. He instructed them, “The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for the harvest (Luke 10:2).” Jesus further advises them as to the type of people they will encounter, what they are to take with them, to offer peace, healing and the promise of his Kingdom. If this is rejected, then move on. Every one of us is a disciple of the Lord. For most of us our discipleship is guided by our Baptism and Sunday reception of Holy Communion—to live a life in fidelity to the Lord’s Word and to be a witness to this Word among our families and friends. For some of us our discipleship is guided by the Sacrament of Holy Orders as well—to preach and teach the Word of the Lord in all its truth and clarity. Like those first seventy-two disciples, we are sent by the Lord into a great harvest—to everyone who crosses our path—and to announce the peace and the Kingdom of God. Hearing today’s Gospel reminds us that we must be intentional about this task, fortified by Christ himself, and hope for a loving reception of what only Christ can offer. Sometimes, what we offer, sadly, is rejected, even by family and friends, and we need to move on—not away. We move on with prayer for those who cannot receive the Word of the Lord. We hope, with confidence in Christ, that he is always at work to return all to his Father.

*The sacred relics of the Martin Saints, Saint Therese, the Little Flower, and her parents, Saints Louis and Zelig Martin, are located in the baptistry of the Cathedral Basilica.* The beautiful reliquary and relics were a gift to the Archdiocese of Philadelphia at the time of the *Magnificat* celebration in 2013 and for many years were located at the Carmelite Monastery in Philadelphia for prayer and veneration. The Martin Saints remind all our families that they form the domestic church and have the duty to encourage one another in a truly Christian way of life. The feast day of Saints Louis and Zelig Martin is this Saturday, July 12. Visit and pray at these relics for your family! *Holy Martin Saints, pray for us!*

*Summer is a good time for some additional reading, especially some spiritual reading.* I encourage you to read the life of a saint or a book on prayer. Our Cathedral Shop provides many fine books for spiritual reading. Consider stopping by the Cathedral Shop and see what is available for some good and enriching summertime reading.

*Plans are underway for our fall sessions for Christian Initiation of Adults.* If you are interested in being a parish sponsor for one of our adult candidates, please contact the Parish Office, 215-561-1313. The parish sponsor does not need to be an expert in the knowledge of the Faith. Rather, the parish sponsor is someone who guides, who mentors, the candidate on the journey to follow Jesus faithfully in his Church.

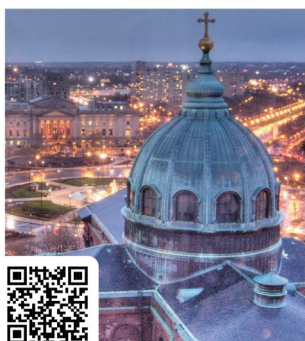

## REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

*Hoy es el decimocuarto domingo del Tiempo Ordinario.* En el evangelio de este domingo, escuchamos cómo el Señor Jesús envió a setenta y dos discípulos delante de él a los pueblos y lugares que pretendía visitar. Les instruyó: «La cosecha es mucha y los trabajadores pocos. Rueguen, por lo tanto, al dueño de la mies que envíe trabajadores a sus campos.» (Lucas 10:2). Jesús les aconseja además sobre el tipo de personas que encontrarán, qué deben llevar consigo, para ofrecerles paz, sanación y la promesa de su reino. Si esto es rechazado, entonces sigan adelante. Cada uno de nosotros es discípulo del Señor. Para la mayoría, nuestro discipulado se guía por el Bautismo y la recepción dominical de la Sagrada Comunión: para vivir una vida fiel a la Palabra del Señor y ser testigos de ella entre nuestras familias y amigos. Para algunos, nuestro discipulado también se guía por el Sacramento del Orden Sagrado: para predicar y enseñar la Palabra del Señor en toda su verdad y claridad. Al igual que aquellos primeros setenta y dos discípulos, nosotros somos enviados por el Señor a una gran cosecha —a todo aquel que se cruce en nuestro camino— y a anunciar la paz y el Reino de Dios. Escuchar el evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que debemos ser conscientes de esta tarea, fortalecidos por Cristo mismo, y esperar una recepción amorosa de lo que solo Él puede ofrecer. A veces, lamentablemente, lo que ofrecemos es rechazado, incluso por familiares y amigos, y debemos seguir adelante, no alejarnos. Seguimos adelante con la oración por quienes no pueden recibir la Palabra del Señor. Esperamos, con confianza en Cristo, que él siempre esté trabajando para devolver todo a su Padre.

*Las sagradas reliquias de los Martin Saints, Santa Teresa, la Pequeña Flor, y sus padres, los santos Luis y Zelig Martín, se encuentran en el baptisterio de la Catedral Basílica.* El hermoso relicario y las reliquias fueron un regalo a la Arquidiócesis de Filadelfia con motivo de la celebración del Magnificat en 2013 y durante muchos años se conservaron en el Monasterio Carmelita de Filadelfia para su oración y veneración. Los Santos Martín recuerdan a todas nuestras familias que forman la iglesia doméstica y tienen el deber de animarse mutuamente en una vida verdaderamente cristiana. La festividad de los Santos Luis y Zelig Martín es este sábado 12 de julio. ¡Visiten y recen ante estas reliquias por su familia! ¡Santos Martín, rueguen por nosotros!

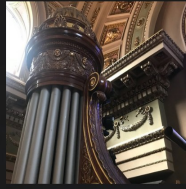
