






Communion


Greeting, Blessing and Dismissal




GLORIA CONGREGATIONAL MASS JOHN LEE Cantor: Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.




Cantor: we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory.




Cantor: Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father.






