Dear Parishioners,

This is the Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time. Humility!
 This was the episcopal motto of Saint Charles Borromeo, the Archbishop of the prestigious Archdiocese of Milan, Italy, who died in 1584. Saint Charles was an example of great humility and inspired others to be humble as well. Humility was no easy accomplishment for this very educated and refined Bishop of the Church. Yet, with God’s help, humility is one of his legacies. I highlight Saint Charles because many of us can listen to this Sunday’s Gospel invitation to be humble and think it is not possible for several reasons. We just cannot get that *close to the ground* (the Latin root of the word humility). However, Jesus is clear in his directive for his followers. “For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted (Luke 14, 11).” One of the greatest helps to humility is an association with the poor—going out of our way for someone in need. This keeps us close to the ground!

This Monday, September 1, 2025, is Labor Day, the unofficial end of summer. Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 AM in the Cathedral Chapel. Following Mass, everyone is welcome to join in praying the Holy Rosary. I encourage you to take this holiday opportunity to join in the celebration of Holy Mass and the Holy Rosary. The Basilica and Parish Office will be closed on Labor Day.

This Monday, September 1, also marks the annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Pope Francis established this observance in 2015 following a similar observance in the Eastern Church. The created world points to the majesty and providence of Almighty God and how he has entrusted to us stewardship over all the earth. We do not have to look too far to see how creation in every form suffers from neglect and abuse of all types. As we pray for the care of creation, it prompts us to action and reminds us that our primary care must be directed to the crown of creation, human life, from the first moment of conception until natural death. Please join this intention to your personal prayers this Monday.

Invite a family member, a neighbor and/or a friend to join you for Holy Mass next Sunday at the Cathedral Basilica.

Please keep the intention for peace in our world, especially those parts most torn apart by war, in your prayers. Our Lady, Queen of Peace, pray for us!

REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Este es el vigésimo segundo domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. ¡Humildad!
Este fue el lema episcopal de San Carlos Borromeo, arzobispo de la prestigiosa Arquidiócesis de Milán, Italia, quien falleció en 1584. San Carlos fue un ejemplo de gran humildad e inspiró a otros a ser humildes también. La humildad no fue fácil de alcanzar para este obispo de la Iglesia, tan culto y refinado. Sin embargo, con la ayuda de Dios, la humildad es uno de sus legados. Destaco a San Carlos porque muchos de nosotros, al escuchar la invitación del evangelio de este domingo a ser humildes, podemos pensar que no es posible por varias razones. Simplemente no podemos llegar tan abajo (la raíz latina de la palabra humildad). Sin embargo, Jesús es claro en su directiva para sus seguidores: «Porque el que se engrandece a sí mismo, será humillado; y el que se humilla, será engrandecido» (Lucas 14, 11). Una de las mayores ayudas para la humildad es la asociación con los pobres: hacer un esfuerzo por quien lo necesita. ¡Esto nos mantiene cerca de la tierra!

Este lunes, 1 de septiembre del 2025, es el Día del Trabajo, el fin no oficial del verano. La misa se celebrará a las 9:00 AM en la Capilla de la Catedral. Después de la misa, todos están invitados a unirse al rezo del Santo Rosario. Los animo a aprovechar esta oportunidad festiva para unirse a la celebración de la Santa Misa y el Santo Rosario. La Basílica y la Oficina Parroquial estarán cerradas el Día del Trabajo.

Este lunes, 1 de septiembre, también se conmemora la Jornada Mundial de Oración por el Cuidado de la Creación. El Papa Francisco estableció esta celebración en 2015, siguiendo una celebración similar en la Iglesia Oriental. El mundo creado señala la majestad y la providencia de Dios Todopoderoso y cómo nos ha confiado la administración de toda la tierra. No tenemos que mirar muy lejos para ver cómo la creación, en todas sus formas, sufre de negligencia y abuso de todo tipo. Al orar por el cuidado de la creación, nos impulsa a la acción y nos recuerda que nuestra prioridad debe estar dirigida a la corona de la creación, la vida humana, desde el primer momento de la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Por favor, unan esta intención a sus oraciones personales este lunes.

Por favor, mantengan en sus oraciones la intención por la paz en nuestro mundo, especialmente en las zonas más devastadas por la guerra. ¡Nuestra Señora, Reina de la Paz, ruega por nosotros!

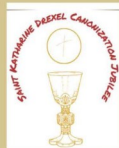
