Dear Parishioners,

Today we observe the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed or All Souls Day. In every Mass we pray for those who have died. On this day however, we pray in a most intentional way for all the faithful departed. We have profound confidence in the power of the saving Death and Resurrection of Christ in the Eucharist to aid all our beloved dead on their way to Heaven. The Eucharist brings to our beloved dead the forgiveness of all their sins and the fullness of the gift of Eternal Life. In addition to the Masses offered on All Souls Day for the deceased, Mass will be offered frequently during the month of November for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. You are invited to have your beloved dead remembered during the month of November by providing their names on the All Souls envelopes and also with the All Souls Memorial Candle. Please see elsewhere in the parish bulletin for more information on the All Souls Memorial Candle. It is a praiseworthy practice to arrange for Mass to be offered for someone who has died, especially soon after their death. You can arrange for Masses on the occasion of the death of a family member or friend at the Parish Office and in the Sacristy after the Sunday Masses. *Each Sunday of November, the musical prelude to Mass will focus our attention on praying for the Holy Souls.*

Next Sunday, the Cathedral Parish will participate in the Annual Seminary Collection, *Shepherds for the Flock*. This collection taken throughout the Archdiocese of Philadelphia at this time of the year is one of the principal sources of income for the operation of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary. Our transitional deacon, Rev. Mr. Chike Egbufoama, will speak next Sunday before each Mass about the Seminary. Your financial and prayerful support of the Seminary and its mission are greatly appreciated. For more information on this important collection for the Seminary or to make your contribution online, please see, scs.edu/appeal.

On Sunday, November 16, 2025, we will have a Holy Hour of Prayer for the Safe and Just Care of Migrants. This Holy Hour will take place at 5:30 PM. This is a most important intention for our prayers, and our prayer is strengthened when we come together to pray. Confessions will also take place as usual during this period. Please mark your calendars for this opportunity.

Please keep the intention for peace in the world and our city in your prayers. Our Lady, Queen of Peace, pray for us!

I am very grateful to all our parishioners and some of our visitors for your generous response to our annual Parish Fall Collection (Block Collection). If you have not already made your contribution, please consider doing so this week.
