Cornelia Peacock was born in Philadelphia in 1809 and later married Pierce Connelly, an Episcopalian minister in 1831 after converting from the Presbyterian Church.

She gave birth to five children, two of whom passed away tragically and very young.

She converted to Catholicism, and following her husband's conversion and ordination into the Catholic priesthood, she founded the Society of the Holy Child Jesus.
