

Dear Parishioners,

This is the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Holy Gospel for this Sunday provides a wonderful preparation for Lent. The Lord gives a fuller explanation for observing the commandments along with some excellent examples. It is insufficient only to know the commandments as a follower of the Lord or even to observe them only in an overarching way. Rather, as the Lord instructs, we are to obey them completely and teach others to do the same. In the days ahead as we anticipate Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent, let us spend some time, with the Ten Commandments in mind, looking for the ways, we need to address our failure or omission to be true to the ways of the Lord. Let us commit with the nearness of Lent to seek more sincerely to turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel.

This Wednesday, February 18, 2026, is Ash Wednesday. Please see the Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday elsewhere in this edition of the parish bulletin. Every year, even though we know that it is coming, Ash Wednesday seems to arrive very quickly. These few days before the beginning of Lent give us the opportunity to plan our own personal observance of this holy time. The Forty Days of Lent beckon us anew to be about the necessary work of a follower of Christ, to turn away from sin and be faithful, even more so, to his Gospel. The Lenten disciplines and practices are intended to guide and help us on this path. I encourage you to review carefully the insert in the parish bulletin listing so many Lenten opportunities at the Cathedral Parish and determine now your plan for Lent, including your Lenten confession.

Next Sunday, February 22, 2026, the catechumens and candidates for the Easter Sacraments here at the Cathedral Parish will participate in the 3:00 PM Rite of Election of Catechumens and of Calling the Candidates to Continuing Conversion in the Cathedral Basilica. You are most welcome to join our catechumens and candidates for this important step on their path to the Easter Sacraments. With this rite, the Archbishop elects the catechumens to be baptized at the Easter Vigil and instructs them to make a good Lent. The candidates are encouraged, as already baptized Christians, to persevere during Lent with prayer and penance to prepare for the completion of their Christian Initiation with Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist. Let us pray for all the catechumens and candidates for the Easter Sacraments throughout the Archdiocese.

Next Sunday, the annual Catholic Charities Appeal begins, Giving Hope to All 2026. The Catholic Charities benefits countless groups, organizations and agencies in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The appeal is conducted primarily through the mail, but it is also possible to support the appeal through the Sunday Collection. REFLEXIÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Este es el sexto domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. El santo evangelio de este domingo nos ofrece una maravillosa preparación para la Cuaresma. El Señor ofrece una explicación más completa sobre la observancia de los mandamientos, junto con excelentes ejemplos. No basta con conocer los mandamientos como seguidores del Señor, ni siquiera con observarlos solo de forma general. Más bien, como el Señor nos instruye, debemos obedecerlos completamente y enseñar a otros a hacer lo mismo. En los próximos días, mientras anticipamos el Miércoles de Ceniza y el comienzo de la Cuaresma, dediquemos un tiempo, con los Diez Mandamientos en mente, a buscar las maneras en que debemos abordar nuestro fracaso u omisión para ser fieles a los caminos del Señor. Comprométamonos, con la cercanía de la Cuaresma, a buscar con mayor sinceridad alejarnos del pecado y ser fieles al evangelio.

Este miércoles, 18 de febrero del 2026, es el Miércoles de Ceniza. Consulten el horario de misas del Miércoles de Ceniza en otra parte de este boletín parroquial. Cada año, aunque sabemos que se acerca, el Miércoles de Ceniza parece llegar muy rápido. Estos días previos al inicio de la Cuaresma nos brindan la oportunidad de planificar nuestra propia observancia de este tiempo sagrado. Los Cuarenta Días de Cuaresma nos invitan de nuevo a dedicarnos a la obra necesaria del seguimiento de Cristo: a alejarnos del pecado y ser fieles, aún más, a su evangelio. Las disciplinas y prácticas cuaresmales tienen como objetivo guiarnos y ayudarnos en este camino. Los animo a revisar atentamente el folleto del boletín parroquial que enumera las diversas oportunidades cuaresmales en la Parroquia Catedral y a definir ahora su plan para la Cuaresma, incluyendo su confesión cuaresmal.

El próximo domingo 22 de febrero del 2026, los catecúmenos y candidatos a los Sacramentos de Pascua, aquí en la Parroquia Catedral, participarán en el Rito de Elección de Catecúmenos y el Llamado a la Conversión Continua de los Candidatos a las 3:00 PM en la Catedral Basílica. Los invito a unirse a nuestros catecúmenos y candidatos en este importante paso en su camino hacia los Sacramentos de Pascua. Con este rito, el Arzobispo elige a los catecúmenos que serán bautizados en la Vigilia Pascual y les instruye a tener una buena Cuaresma. Se anima a los candidatos, como cristianos ya bautizados, a perseverar durante la Cuaresma con oración y penitencia para prepararse para completar su Iniciación Cristiana con la Confirmación y la Sagrada Eucaristía. Oremos por todos los catecúmenos y candidatos a los Sacramentos de Pascua de toda la Arquidiócesis.

El próximo domingo comienza la Campaña Anual de Caridades Católicas, Dando Esperanza a Todos 2026.
